LEADERSHIP TEAM MEETING - WINTERSTOWN UMC

October 20th at 6:30 PM

Prayer- Dawn offered the prayer to start the meeting.

Danielle, being the guest, went first to bring the team up to date on the Growing Friends activities.

- They still have a waiting list of individuals wanting to bring children to day care.
- She has one person scheduled for an interview and one that is currently shadowing.
- She is still working on the new Employee Handbook and hopes to have it ready to hand out for the new year.
- She submitted the application for the first grant, that will be used to offset the costs of training and CE.
- Maintenance needed: the hooks outside of the baby room are falling off the wall and asking if hooks could be added to the one's room.
- Trunk or Treat was scheduled for Tuesday, October 30, 2025, at 10 am for the small children and again at 3:30 pm for the school aged children.
- The Thanksgiving dinner for GF will be held on November 20, 2025, at 11:30 am. If you are free and are able to lend a hand, it would be greatly appreciated.
- December 17, 2025, between 9:30 and 11:30 am, Santa will arrive. (Bill W. will be making some contacts for this). At that time, he will pass out gifts.
- Pastor Becky congratulated Danielle on a superb job that she is doing in taking over as the director of GF, both with the daily running of the daycare and the financial end as well.
- Pastor Becky then made her announcement about her upcoming retirement plans, prior to Danielle excusing herself from the meeting.

Connie gave her report as follows:

- We are paid up to date on our insurance and pension; however, we still owe \$10,800 in shares of ministry. We had so many unexpected maintenance expenses that needed immediate attention and put us behind in the SOM.
- A motion was made by Gabe and seconded by Bill to move the monies designated as mission money to the operating fund, since we have no planned missions scheduled.
- The announcement was made that the shares of ministry for 2026, have been decreased by 7.9 %, totaling \$26,724.89.
- Quinn Waldrup is doing a fundraising event of selling Mr. Sticky Buns, to assist with the HVAC monies needed to install the new system. The orders and money are due by November 2, 2025, and pick up will be on Nove 13th, 2025 from 3:30 to 7:30 pm. Buddy made a motion and it was seconded by Ann, to go ahead with the HVAC project, as soon as we had all the monies per the contract presented. Buddy signed the agreement for the company.
- We had a discussion of the use of the APR room, regarding suggested offering amounts as well as all honorariums needed for funerals, etc. in the future, to present to families.
- The tree will be in the hallway to remember all of our members who now live in heaven for all Saints Day, on November 2. 2025. This same tree will then be used as the Angel Tree, to assist families in need to have the same special memories of a wonderful Christmas that we are all blessed to have.
- We are planning on Christmas decorating on Black Friday, so anyone who is able to assist, please come out and join in the fun.
- The communion for November was held in the pews, due to the candles set up for All Saints Day.
- We are looking into how to enhance the visits to those who can't make it to church and possibly being able to offer communion.

Pastor Becky offered the closing prayer, and the meeting adjourned at 8:30 pm.

Prior to everyone leaving, we had cupcakes and ice cream to celebrate Ann's birthday.

Due in part to a much higher volume of maintenance expenses incurred year to date against budget, the leadership team voted to withhold additional Shares of Ministry payments for now.

We were able to reach our goal for the contracted amount of \$25,400. As of November 24, the installation of the new HVAC system has been completed.
