What you do:


- 1. Measure flour into the large bowl. Add baby oil.

Dear Beloved Children of God,

CHILDREN'C

There has been some excellent feedback that we should have children's Sunday school all year round. That's an awesome suggestion! I was thinking how great it would have been to be able to invite the children who attended VBS and their families back to worship and children's Sunday school (if we had it) the week after the children led worship. However, I know that it is sometimes challenging for children (and therefore their parents) to make it through the whole service. On the other hand, though, it is my sincere desire that our current Sunday school and Simply Loved teachers don't get burned out! We all need some breaks and some sabbath time from even our service to God, the one who stressed the need for sabbath clear back in Genesis chapter 2.

So, while it's too late for us to have children's Sunday school this summer, here's how I hope it can work for next summer. As we have been doing, we won't have children's Sunday school when we have Communion. That way children will be able to participate in that sacrament. So, there are 11 Sundays left for which we need a teacher and a second adult. There are enough of us who don't teach the children to lead the children in a Bible story and activity for those 11 Sundays. Of course, any teacher who wants to take one Sunday will certainly not be told they can't! I will even

take one Sunday if necessary. We can provide as much or as little as the teacher for a Sunday wants (for example: specific Bible story, activities, coloring pages, song list. If you are a "craft" person, then you'll have some great ideas.) This will offer you a wonderful opportunity to engage in ministry and interact with the children with whom we've been blessed! If you don't already have your clearances and background checks which are needed to engage in children's ministry, then you have 10 months to get them. Amber, our administrative assistant, will help you.

If you want to serve in some other ways much sooner, there are two opportunities this month. First, on Tuesday, Aug. 6th, we will again be the host site for North Hopewell Township Police Department's "National Night Out." There will be a lot to set up on Monday (Aug. 5th) and Tuesday, and hot dogs to hand out during the event which is from 5 – 8 pm. Then, of course, there will be cleaning up afterwards.



The second way to engage in ministry is to help with the dinner which is being offered to the families of Growing Friends (GF) on Thursday, Aug. 15th. Thursday at 6 pm is "Meet the Teacher" night at the NH-W Elementary School. So, to help the GF families, we will serve them dinner from 5-5:45pm. Before they leave, we will offer a "back to school blessing." Please let me know if you can help with this meal.

While summer isn't technically over under Sept. 21st this year, the slightly "slower" season is coming to an end too quickly! Soon the children will be back in school and hopefully in Simply Loved and children's Sunday school. Thank you to Tammy Waldrup, our "Nurture Coordinator," and all the teachers who help the children to know how much Jesus loves them - and us, too!

FINANCIAL STANDING

Thank you for your continued giving from both the financial aspect as well as your time and service. There has been an increase in the amount of financial giving, and we thank all those that have been able to increase the amount of their tithes and offerings. During our recent issue with our drinking water because of the UV light you have been generous in providing gallon jugs of water or giving monetary donations to cover the purchase of water. Contributions are received in varying amounts and from many sources and used towards operating expenses. We recently had recycling that netted \$148 and the United Women in Faith project for Father's Day netted \$207. The Gift Card purchases to Giant and Jerry's has netted \$550 based on the 5% discount from the vendors.

The Shares of Ministry monthly expense payments remain in arrears for the months of February through July. At the end of June 2024, the amount in arrears was \$12,810.55. During this time of the year, we do not have the large fuel oil expenses, but we do have other supplemental expenses including increased electricity and the second round of 2024 Real Estate taxes. Apart from the Shares of Ministry, we have been able to meet our normal operating expenses.



WATER UPDATE

A big thank you to everyone who donated water as we awaited approval and installation of our updated water system. The water kept us and Growing Friends in operation until the system was replaced to meet the Department of Environmental Protection's standard. We appreciate the understanding and kindness you all have shown as we dealt with the situation. It was a long and tedious process but it is finally completed.
