Message From the Pastor


Dear Beloved Children of God.

Well, by now you have probably realized that the reason we had a worship series on change is because we're about to go through one. Back in February we had an all-church meeting at which leadership shared the concerns over the finances of the church. So many of you have increased your tithes and offering amounts since that meeting, and on behalf of the leadership team, we are VERY GRATEFUL!!! Sadly, though, we continue to have more expenses than offerings. So, the leadership team reached out to our District Superintendent (DS,) Rev. Dr. Gary Weaver, and invited him to discuss our options. Becoming a



charge with another church and changing the pastoral appointment to 3/4 time were possibilities we shared during the February church meeting, and they were also discussed during the meeting with our DS.

However, the DS returned with a different and better solution. Instead of becoming a charge with another church which means we'd have shared ministries, shared leadership, and share a pastor, the DS is putting Winterstown and Bethany Felton together into what is called a cooperative parish. Per The UMC Book of Discipline, a cooperative parish is described as:



¶ 206. 1. Local churches, with the guidance of the Holy Spirit, may enhance their witness to one another and to the world by showing forth the love of Jesus Christ through forms of mutual cooperation. There are different types of cooperative parishes. Winterstown is becoming "Winterstown, Extended" with Bethany Felton, and I, Pastor Becky, will serve both churches. This is described in ¶ 206. 2. in The Book of Discipline: 2. Extended or Shared Ministry—a larger membership church sharing ministry with a smaller membership church, usually served by the pastor(s) of the larger church.

In this arrangement, both churches are autonomous. They share the pastor, and they may share in ministries if they choose, but they each have their own organizational structure. The one exception is that Winterstown and Bethany Felton will share a Staff Parish Relationship Committee (SPRC.) The DS has determined that there will be 6 members from Winterstown and 3 members from Bethany Felton.

The biggest changes which follow from this new arrangement which become effective on Oct. 1st are to the worship times of both churches. So that the same pastor can be at both worship services, Bethany will have to start earlier, and Winterstown will have to start later (10:30 am.) Since the pastor is shared by both churches, both churches cover a portion of the costs of the pastor. This helps to reduce the pastoral costs by almost 25% for Winterstown. What is something you should know is that since Winterstown owns the parsonage, Bethany is not obligated to pay any of those expenses. However,

Gary shared that one of the leaders at Bethany said they (Bethany) will help with a portion of the utility costs as well! What a beautiful and generous offer!

CHRISTIAN SYMBOL - CHRISTIAN FLAG

Dating to the early 20th century, the Christian flag represents all of Christianity, though it's been used primarily in the Americas and Africa. FINANCIAL STANDING

The Shares of Ministry monthly expense payments remain in arrears for the months of February through September. At the end of September 2024, the amount in arrears for those eight months will be \$20,496.88 (8 x \$2,562.11/mo).

A contribution in the amount of \$3,350 was received in September from the Senior Youth from the net proceeds of the 2024 Easter Candy project. This money will be used towards WUMC operating expenses. Conversely, maintenance expenses paid during September totaled approximately \$2,600. Fall is now here and while that should mean lower expenses for electricity and final expenses for 2024 lawn mowing, there will be upcoming increased expenses for fuel oil.

Thank you for the continued giving of your time, service, and financial support. As written in 2 Corinthians 9:7-8 (NLT), "You must each make up your own mind as to how much you should give. Don't give reluctantly or in response to pressure. For God loves the person who gives cheerfully. And God will generously provide all you need. Then you will always have everything you need and plenty left over to share with others."


SPECIAL GUEST:
