This certifies _____, here referred to as Mare Owner/Agent, has engaged one service to the stallion **JR DRIFTWOOD ZEUS**, AQHA #5002104 for the mare _____, Reg # _____ for the 2021 breeding season beginning February 1, 2021. The mare owner agrees to pay a breeding fee of **\$800**, which includes a **\$200 nonrefundable** booking fee. All payments must be made payable to Arrow B. **Regardless of whether the breeding is through a service auction or donated breeding agreement, a \$200 nonrefundable booking fee is still applicable for all contracts.**

This contract is made and entered into on this _____ day of _____, 20____. Mare owner agrees to breed the mare stated above for the fee of \$800 for a live foal subject to the following conditions:

1. The stallion fee includes a nonrefundable booking fee of \$200 payable with this contract, the balance of which must be paid before semen is collected and/or 30 days before mare is delivered for live coverage.
2. A. Stallion will live cover mares at Arrow B Arena.
B. All collection services will be handled by _____. All booking and stud fees must be paid IN FULL before any semen will be shipped or live coverage breeding.
3. Multiple embryo transfer if more than one embryo is produced from stallion breeding under this agreement and if multiple embryos are transferred, then mare owner must notify stallion owner within 48 hours of transfer of embryo(s). If embryo transfer results in multiple pregnancies, then mare owner must pay stallion owner for each pregnancy.
4. This contract contains a **live foal guarantee**. A live foal is described as a newborn foal which stands and nurses without assistance. If a foal is born dead, there are return privileges for the next breeding season only if breeder is notified within 7 days and receives a veterinarian's statement of death. If after pronounced "safe in foal", the mare should miscarry, abort, or prove barren after leaving the breeders premises, the mare owner has the privilege to return her for breeding during **current breeding season or the following season, only**.
5. If the mare owner fails to rebreed the mare the following year from the original contract, then any and all fees become forfeited, the right to rebreed is cancelled and the stallion owner is released from all further

obligation of this contract, unless otherwise agreed in writing and signed by both parties.

6. Mare owner may not assign this breeding contract or substitute any other mare the mare under this agreement without the prior consent of stallion owner. If a mare dies or is deemed unfit to breed during breeding season, stallion owner may approve a substitute mare. Any attempted assignment without the prior consent of stallion owner will, at the option of the stallion owner, terminate this agreement and release stallion owner from all obligations hereunder.

6. To guarantee shipping, mare owner, must give (at minimum) a 24-hour notice of possible semen shipment required to _____ and confirm shipment prior to actual shipment.

7. Every effort will be made to accommodate your mare's breeding timeframe; however, it is the mare owner's responsibility to keep in touch with Arrow B so that your veterinarian and ours can get your mare in foal on a timely basis. Failure to adhere to these agreements may result in missed heats and delayed shipments, at the mare owner's expense. A veterinarian knowledgeable in successful insemination techniques must oversee offsite inseminations, in order to maximize the potential of a timely pregnancy.

8. The mare owner agrees to have the mare checked by ultrasound no later than 18 days after insemination. If ultrasound is unavailable, mare owner agrees to have the mare checked for pregnancy by a licensed veterinarian within 30 days of insemination. Mare owner agrees to provide Arrow B with the results of the pregnancy exam no later than 30 days after insemination and last breeding date.

9. Normal breeding season is February 1 to July 1.

10. A breeder's certificate will be issued for the foal, conceived by this mating when the mare has produced a live foal by this mating.

11. If stallion dies or becomes unfit for breeding in the opinion of stallion owner, this agreement at the option of stallion owner, immediately terminate on behalf of mare owner. The stallion service fee (less booking fee) will be refunded and the stallion owner and mare owner will be released from any further obligations under this agreement. If the stallion is sold, the new stallion owner will honor rebreeds for one year from the date of breeding. No refunds will be issued if stallion is sold.

Shipment Information and Additional Charges for Cooled Transported Semen:

It is the mare owner's responsibility to order a shipment at least 24 hours in advance. Confirmation calls must be received by 9 AM on day of collection.

1. Semen will be sent via Fed-Ex (next day arrival) at a rate of \$300 per shipment within the US. All Canadian Fed-ex shipments are \$550 which includes the USDA health certificate and fees.
2. Counter to counter airline shipments (same day arrival) are available at a rate of \$400 per shipment. Availability of airline shipment depends on air cargo routes operated by airlines contracted.
3. If Fed-Ex delivery is not available within a 24 hourr period, additional notice will be required. Mare owner should check with Fed Ex for weekend, holiday delivery or customer pickup.
4. Cooled semen that is picked up from _____ by mare owner or agent will have a collection and packaging cost of \$200.
5. Arrow B shall not be responsible for the costs arising from shipments lost, damaged, or delayed in transit, or condition of cooled shipped semen upon delivery. We have no control of the shipment after it leaves our custody.
6. Customer must specify shipment method, overnight delivery or airline counter to counter service, when ordering semen. For counter to counter, customer must provide name of destination airport where shipment is to be sent.
7. It is the mare owner's responsibility to return a copy of the INSEMINATION CERTIFICATE, signed by administering Veterinarian or Breeding Facility Manager to Arrow B. Mare owner is also responsible for blood typing or DNA testing their mare per AQHA rule # 209 or APHA rule RG-165.
8. Mare will not be put on stallion breeding report unless all fees have been paid in full and last breeding date has been provided.

This agreement contains the entire agreement between the parties and may be amended in writing signed by each of the parties. Nebraska law governs this agreement.

PAYMENT INFORMATION:

All payments may be made by check or PayPal and must be in US Funds. If paying by check simply leave PayPal information space below blank. All PayPal invoices must be made within 48 hours upon receipt. All processing and shipping fees are subject to change. Payments must be made in full prior to shipping semen or live cover.
