









The Book

- The time between the 1st writer and the 40th writer is more than 1,500 years.




Most of the writers of the books in the Bible did not know each other.

But the Bible Is Miraculously Consistent!






Genesis 3:15 ¹⁵ And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise His heel.

Micah 5:2 ² "But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, *Though* you are little among the thousands of Judah, *Yet* out of you shall come forth to Me The One to be Ruler in Israel, Whose goings forth *are* from of old, From everlasting."

John 1:41 ⁴¹ He first found his own brother Simon, and said to him, "We have found the Messiah" (which is translated, the Christ).



Isaiah 46:9-10 ⁹ Remember the former things of old, For I *am* God, and *there is* no other; *I am* God, and *there is* none like Me, ¹⁰ Declaring the end from the beginning, And from ancient times things that are not yet done, Saying, My counsel shall stand, And I will do all My pleasure (NKJ).



Luke 24:44-45 ⁴⁴ Then He said to them, "These are the words which I spoke to you while I was still with you, that all things must be fulfilled which were written in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms concerning Me." ⁴⁵ And He opened their understanding, that they might comprehend the Scriptures (NKJ).

Here is what the Law of Moses, the Prophets, and the Psalms say about the coming Messiah:

The Law of Moses:

Genesis 3:15 ¹⁵ And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise His heel.

Deuteronomy 18:15 ¹⁵The Lord your God will raise up for you a Prophet like me from your midst, from your brethren. Him you shall hear.

The Prophets:

Isaiah 42:1 ¹Behold! My Servant whom I uphold, My Elect One in whom My soul delights! I have put My Spirit upon Him; He will bring forth justice to the Gentiles.

Isaiah 50:6 ⁶I gave My back to those who struck Me, and My cheeks to those who plucked out the beard; I did not hide My face from shame and spitting.

Isaiah 53:1-12

Micah 5:2 ² "But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, *Though* you are little among the thousands of Judah, *Yet* out of you shall come forth to Me The One to be Ruler in Israel, Whose goings forth *are* from of old, From everlasting."



What About the Psalms?

Matthew 27:45-46 ⁴⁵ Now from the sixth hour until the ninth hour there was darkness over all the land. ⁴⁶ And about the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, "Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani?" that is, "My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?" (NKJ)

PSALM 22

My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me? (Ps. 22:1)

⁷All those who see Me ridicule Me; They shoot out the lip, they shake the head, saying, ⁸ "He trusted in the LORD, let Him rescue Him; Let Him deliver Him, since He delights in Him!"

¹⁶ For dogs have surrounded Me; The congregation of the wicked has enclosed Me. They pierced My hands and My feet;

¹⁸ They divide My garments among them, And for My clothing they cast lots.

AT THE CROSS

"My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?" (Matt. 27:46)

"He trusted in God; let Him deliver Him now if He will have Him; for He said,`I am the Son of God." (Matt. 27:43)

³⁹ "Behold My hands and My feet, that it is I Myself. Handle Me and see, for a spirit does not have flesh and bones as you see I have." ⁴⁰ When He had said this, He showed them His hands and His feet" (Luke 24:39-40).
