Our mission

The St. Louis Mullen Foundation is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit whose mission is to bring awareness and financial support to small, St. Louis-based organizations that serve veterans, animals and families in need.

Our origin

A 1999 proclamation by St. Louis Mayor Clarence Harmon declared May 2 as Mike Mullen Day, in recognition of Mike's decades of community service and activism. Fast-forward to 2011, when James Slover decided to celebrate his friend Mike with a surprise parade through the Central West End. That flash-mob celebration became an annual event supporting a variety of St. Louis-area nonprofits that lack the resources to produce their own events. In 2017, we established the St. Louis Mullen Foundation. Mike Mullen Day remains our signature event.

Mike, a St. Louis native, founded Pets Are Wonderful Support (PAWS) and has been active with the St. Louis AIDS Memorial, the St. Louis AIDS Foundation, AIDS Walk and the Animal House Fund. He also served as the HIV/AIDS liaison officer for the St. Louis mayor's office.

Our impact

Since 2011, we have raised tens of thousands of dollars with Mike Mullen Day and other fundraisers. In 2024, Mike Mullen Day proceeds totaled \$27,000, which we divided among three organizations.
