

Registration Form

Payments:

Initial Fees are due by the first of the month. There will be a \$10 late fee assessed for every month a payment is late. Late fees are assessed for all payments received after the 1st of the month. Refunds will **NOT** be given for any reason. Missed classes may **NOT** be pro-rated, carried forward or transferred. The fees remain the same each month, independent of the number of classes per month.

*Sibling discount of \$5.00 per month.

*Discount for yearly tuition, pay 9 months prior to September and get June Free!!!

*The membership fee is due annually, beginning in September and is non-refundable.

Transportation:

Initial Students should arrive on time for class and be picked up promptly. Students waiting for transportation must wait inside the building for an adult.

Class Withdrawal Notices:

Initial All gymnasts are registered for the entire month (classes end in June) unless a written withdrawal form is completed. If you wish to withdraw your child from class before June please stop by the desk to complete a form 14 days before you wish to withdraw. Payment is required at the time through the final date of withdrawal. Once a withdrawal form is completed the gymnast's spot in the class will not be held. Withdrawal notices will NOT be taken over the phone. If no withdrawal form is completed, fees are due the following month. **ALL MAKE UPS MUST BE COMPLETED BEFORE THE GYMNAST'S LAST DAY OF CLASS.**

Snow Days:

Initial Gymnastic classes are rarely canceled due to weather conditions. If classes are canceled an announcement will be made on our machine, our website and Facebook page and also via email and phone blast. If it is not safe for you to travel to class due to weather conditions, please do not travel. You may take a make-up class for any classes missed.

Make Ups:

Initial There is no adjustment of fees for missed classes. Make up classes will be allowed where space is available. Make ups may be scheduled for your child's missed class (includes February and April school closings and Memorial Day). However, if you are absent from the scheduled make up the class will be forfeited. Please email tgpgymnastics@gmail.com to schedule a make-up class. PLEASE DO NOT JUST SHOW UP FOR A MAKE-UP CLASS. Open Gym Passes are also available instead of make-up classes. Once a gymnast has withdrawn from the program he/she may no longer take make up classes.

Parent Observation (classes for 6+ yrs. only):

Initial For your child's safety, we **strongly suggest** you do not stay for observation of his or her class. We will offer several parent watch weeks throughout the year.

Safety:

Initial Please be advised that any activity involving motion or height creates the possibility of accidental injury. Due to the specialized nature of this activity we must reserve the right to refuse instruction, to limit or restrict participation, take whatever action the instructor deems necessary to provide for reasonable safety. Please help your child show respect for their safety and to the demands of the coaches by staying off the equipment without the specific permission and supervision of a coach.

Dress Code:

Initial All gymnasts are required to wear a leotard (boy must be in sports shorts) for the safety of the gymnast and the spotters. For additional safety, students must be BAREFOOT; no socks or sneakers. All gymnasts with long hair should have it tied up with no hair in their face, they need to see what they are doing (we also like to see kids faces).
