

Iowa's 2025 Fire Safety Awareness Focus is on lithium-ion batteries: proper charging of devices and disposal of batteries.

Members of the Spencer Fire Department shared the importance of having a fire safety plan with Trinity Preschoolers. The youth also got to climb into a firetruck for a close-up look at fire equipment and gear.
