#### THE FIRST IDO ONLINE COMPETITION!

IDO will be holding its first ever CONTINENT vs CONTINENT World Championship! This exciting event will take place from March to October with various rounds until the top winner in the world is announced.

All Canadian dancers are invited to participate in the first round - which is the Nationals. Every country will pick their top 20 dancers in each IDO category and age group and send them to the next round - the Continental. Our Canadian champions will compete against dancers from across North America and those top 20 dancers in each IDO category and age group will be sent on to compete against the other continents. We will be using video submissions from 2019 to present. The final round of the competition will offer ca\$h prizes and we want our Canadians on that

virtual podium!! We will send info out once confirmed.

#### **WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS**

2020 OFFICALLY CANCELLED



The remaining 2020 World Championships have all been officially cancelled through IDO. The uncertainty that the fall brings during this novel coronavirus, as well as possible mandatory quarantine measures have made it impossible to plan any world dance event safely. **Safety is paramount.** 

As for Team Canada, we have already stated that if you have been accepted to a 2020 team and have already registered, your positions will be held for 2021. We will contact those dancers who will be moving up an age category as they will need to discuss with the choreographer. Dancers can register on Amilia and make payments for 2021 anytime. If you need assistance, please let us know.

Despite the uncertainty in the world, we are confident that the 2021 IDO World Championships will go ahead. If for any reason they are cancelled, we will follow the same protocol as 2020.

### **WORLD DANCE CHALLENGE - MEXICO**

NEW DATES ANNOUNCED

REFUNDS
\*FULL OR HOLD

As we continue to navigate Covid-19, we will remain diligent in following the restrictions and directives of our Canadian Public Health. Currently, it is impossible to predict the status of where Canada and the rest of the world will be in the next few months, we feel that we must postpone our Team Travels until the 2021 season.

Our rehearsals were to being in August, however, most provinces will still be restricting gatherings at that time. Also, it will be difficult to start practices without knowing if we will be allowed to travel or not in the fall. If competitions are not postponed, and we are allowed to travel, we have to question whether or not there will be a mandatory quarantine after we arrive and/or return home. These are questions that cannot be answered at this time unfortunately.

You have the choice of a FULL REFUND or to hold your payments over to 2021. People who wish to take the full refund must re-audition again next year whereas the others will not. If you have any issues with stopping your payments, please email us to find out how. You may also stop your payments yourself through Amilia.

It is with great sadness that we announce this postponement. Canada has been attending these Championships since 1998 without missing a year. However, the health and welfare of our dancers and their families will always take precedence over any dance event.

FALL/WINTER - EUROPE 2020

This global health crisis caused by Covid-19 is a unique challenge for many of us, and it has impacted many members of the Team Canada Dance and International Dance Organization (IDO) family. We would like to express our concern and support for all of you and your families, our staff, and all others affected by this outbreak.

As we work as a community to prepare for the impact of Covid-19, we wanted to share how Team Canada Dance is addressing the current situation and the impact on our 2020 teams. The health and safetey of our dancers/families, choreographers, and dance studios are our primary concern. Due to the fluid situation, we are making decisions on a day-by-day basis and will update you when our plans change. Presently, the IDO has either postponed or cancelled events up until August 2020 and they will be re-evaluating on a month by month basis with special consideration for the countries involved.

Due to the current world crisis, the IDO has decided to POSTPONE the IDO World Dance Challenge in Monterrey, Mexico that was originally scheduled for July 2020 to July 2021.

You will now have another year to save and prepare for this exciting event! Including dance masters from around the globe adjudicating and offering amazing workshops, over \$20,000 USD in cash prizes to be won during competition, exhibitions, and even

auditions, this is one event you won't want to miss! All genres are included; Performing Arts (Tap, Ballet, Jazz, Comtemporary, Lyrical, Showdance, Acro, and Ethnic/Folk), Street Dance (Hip Hop, Breakdance, Streetdance Show, Disco), and Couples Dance (lating styles).

Team Canada Dance is thrilled to start offering the couples/latin division to our ever expanding repertoire, which will be headed by the world recognized dancer and adjudicator Elena Shvaitser.
