Laser therapy can be used alone or as part of our comprehensive Fertility Wellness Program which includes Acupuncture, Fertility Massage, and Herbal and Nutritional therapy.

LASER THERAPY MAY IMPROVE FERTILITY BY:

- Enhancing ovarian and uterine blood circulation
- Activating the parasympathetic nervous system and enhancing vagal tone (facilitating rest, digestion, reproduction, and nourishment)
- Boosting mitochondrial function and cellular vitality (recharging cell batteries to optimize egg and sperm quality)
- Furnishing energy for proper embryo division

POWERMEDIC DENMARK & NORWAY CLINICAL STUDY:

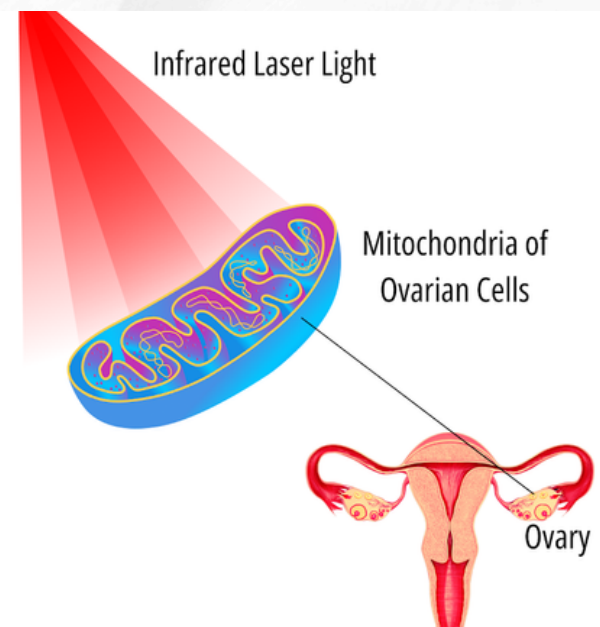
