Compete for the title of State Champ in each division according to the number on your team.

Taking it to the next level!

Public School Divisions For Teams

This number includes dancing members on team and doesn't include managers—but should include non-eligible members.

SMALL: 4 to 15

MEDIUM: 16 to 25

LARGE: 26 to 35

XLARGE: 36 to 45

SUPER: 46+

ELITE: 8 to 24

(Should be a portion of the team under 50%)

ALL MALE: Any Number

INTERMEDIATE/JUNIOR HIGH–SMALL: 4 to 19

INTERMEDIATE/JUNIOR HIGH–MEDIUM: 20 to 35

INTERMEDIATE/JUNIOR HIGH–LARGE: 36+

ELEMENTARY: Any Number

PRIVATE SCHOOL: Any Number

In order to achieve the overall awards, teams must enter 3 routines in the categories listed below. Should any team choose two in the same category, they will compete against themselves.

All team routines must perform at least 50% of their team. Should any team fall short of this, MDDT will alert the director and move that entry into the Elite division. That score cannot be combined with team for awards.

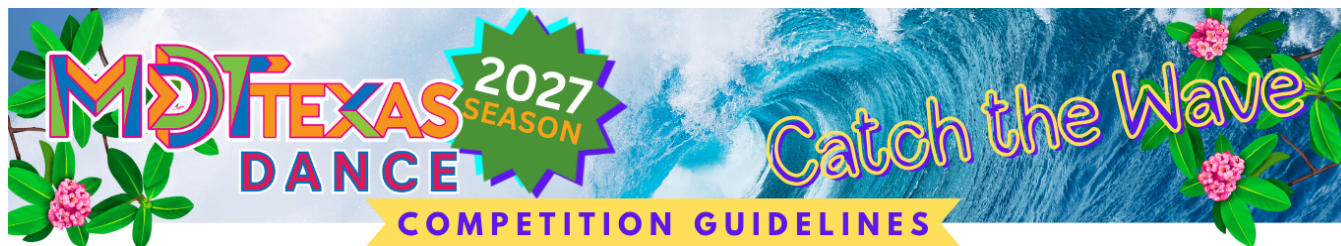

Public School Divisions For Officers

Dance Officers will be divided into 3 divisions (unless combined for lack of competition in one division).



Dance Officers

- * Small: 2 to 3 Officers
- * Medium: 4 to 5 Officers
- * Large: 6+

*The officer line that competes in 3 categories will be eligible for major awards.
Officers must dance the same members in all of their routines.*

Social Officers (NEW)

This division will compete separately and every social officer group has the opportunity to compete for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place using their highest score. (This is different than before.) Each group will take their highest score (if doing more than one) to compete against other Social Officer Groups. The highest score will receive 1st place, then next will be 2nd and next 3rd place.

No other award will be given in the Social Officer Division.

Intermediate/Junior High Public/Private School Division

All teams will compete together and will have the opportunity to win awards in the Intermediate/Junior High Division. *(If there are several teams and sizes are very wide in membership numbers, MDDTTexas reserves the right to create size groupings.)*

Elementary Public/Private School Division

All teams will compete together and will have the opportunity to win awards in the elementary division.

Studio Division

Studios compete for the Regional Title by performing in at least 3 routines using the following age divisions and categories.

- * Tiny/Mascot: (PreK/K-1st grade)
- * Minis/Elementary: (2nd-4th grade)
- * Youth/Intermediate: (5th-6th grade)
- * Juniors: (7th-8th grade)
- * Seniors: (9th-12th grade)

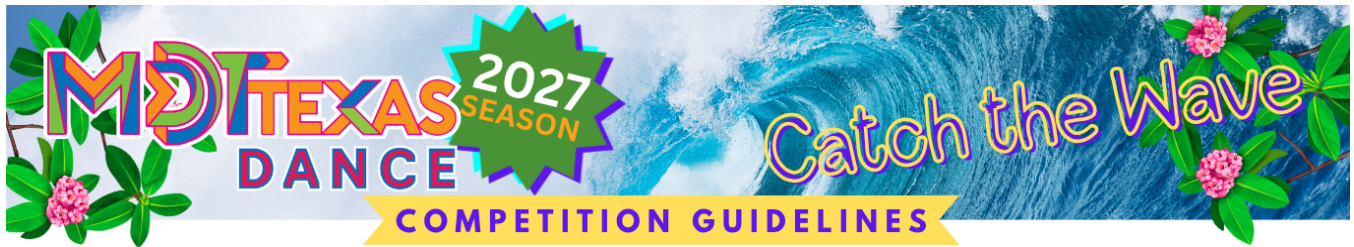
If team has performers in multiple grades, the team should enter in the division that the oldest performer is in ex. performers have 1st graders and 2nd graders—they should enter as Mini-Elementary.

All Team Public/Private/Studio/Dance Officers

ENSEMBLE DIVISION

Any team may compete a select group of dancers as an ensemble.

Ensembles are judged according to their actual team size (even if their team is not competing).

All ensembles are judged together according to size- no matter what genre.

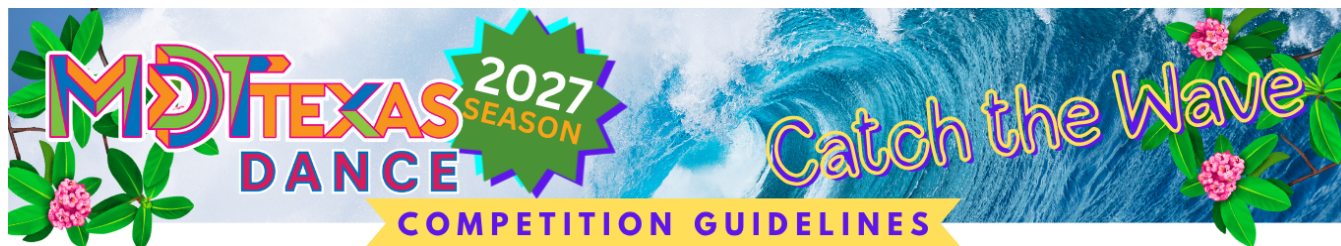
- * Duets: 2 Dancers
- * Trios: 3 Dancers
- * Small Ensembles: 4 to 8 Dancers
- * Medium Ensembles: 9 to 12 Dancers
- * Large Ensembles: 13+ Dancers

SOLO DIVISION

Soloists are separated by Studio and Public/Private School/Independent and by grade level.

We now allow independent soloists and they will compete in the Independent Division.

There will be a winner and 4 runners up in each grade level. The highest scoring senior public school and studio soloist will perform at the beginning of awards.



COMPETITION GUIDELINES

STATE AWARDS

Ensemble Division: Medals will be awarded to each 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winner. Ensembles compete by team size according to website breakdown.

Solo Division—“Tops in Texas”: Recognition will be given to all solo participants who score 90 or higher (90 or above is a Division 1 Rating). 1st—4th place winner placements.

Sweepstakes/Kay-Tee Awards (Super Sweepstakes): Teams/Officers who enter 3 or more team categories and score 280 cumulative points on their top 3 routines.

Choreography Awards: Team/Officers recognition of quality choreography to teams with a **perfect score**.

Technique Awards: Team/Officers recognition of amazing technique to teams with a **perfect score**.

Precision Awards: Team/Officers recognition of impeccable precision to teams with a **perfect score**.

Overall Effect: Team/Officers recognition for outstanding overall effect with a **perfect score**.

Best in Category: Top-scoring routine in each category/division. *Example:* Small Team, Best Jazz; Medium Team, Best Jazz and Overall Best in Category in each genre with more than one entry.

Social Officer Award - Highest Scoring Social Officer routine. (1st, 2nd, 3rd place)

Best in Class: Top-scoring Team/Officers/Specialty Groups in each division. Teams may be combined depending on the number of entries.

Top 3 Team and Officers will receive recognition by being named—**STATE GRAND CHAMPION, STATE CHAMPION, & STATE CHAMPION RESERVE**.

SMALL ENSEMBLE: (4 -8 performers) \$260/per routine

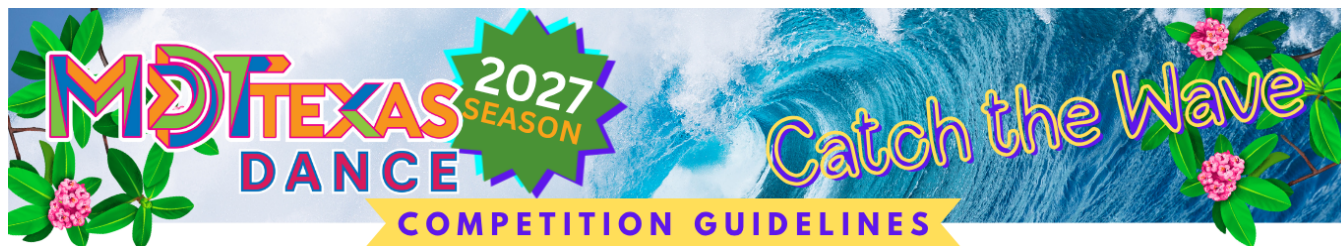
MEDIUM ENSEMBLE: (9-12 performers) \$270/per routine

Between the MDDTTexas Contest and Schools/Studios...

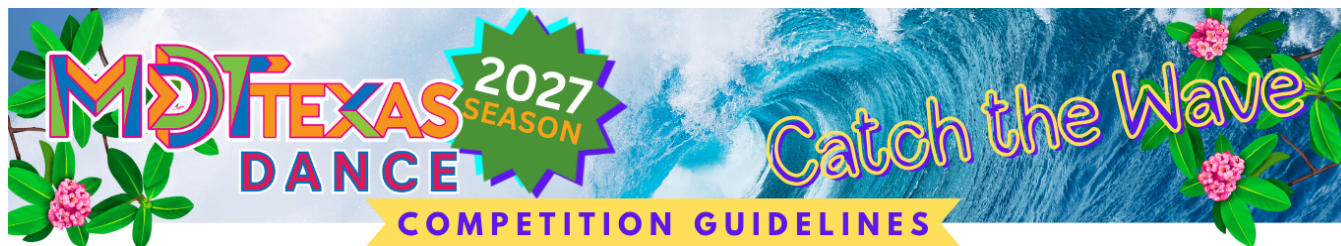

<< DATES & DEADLINES >>

Below, you will find a handful of important dates to keep in mind after you complete registration:

- * Wednesday, 10 days before the contest (if not sooner), a preliminary schedule is emailed.
- * Sunday, the week of the contest, all changes (mistakes) must be submitted to MDDT team member Lynn at schedulemddtt@gmail.com
- * Wednesday, before the contest, a final schedule will be sent by email to the dance team directors.
- * Thursday, before the contest, a schedule will be posted on mddttexas.com website and the updated and most current schedule will be on the website the day of contest.

NOTE: Add/drop deadline for a full refund is two weeks before the contest date. Once the preliminary schedule is emailed, there will be no refunds.

RULES & REQUIRMENTS

<< DANCER PERFORMANCE REQUIREMENTS >>

You must dance 50% of your team.

You will be asked again at the beginning of **2nd semester** for your team count (number on team = all members, eligible and ineligible that are dancers.) This DOES NOT include managers/escorts. If eligibility becomes an issue with team numbers—please let us know at least 2 weeks before the contest, so size adjustments can be made if necessary.

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Should your team dance with less than 50%, you will be automatically entered into the Elite Division.

<< DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY >>

1. Consent to Photography & Recording

Photos and videos may be taken during the event by official photographers, videographers, and authorized media representatives. These images may include participants, audience members, and staff, and may be used for promotional, commercial, or editorial purposes.

2. Usage Rights

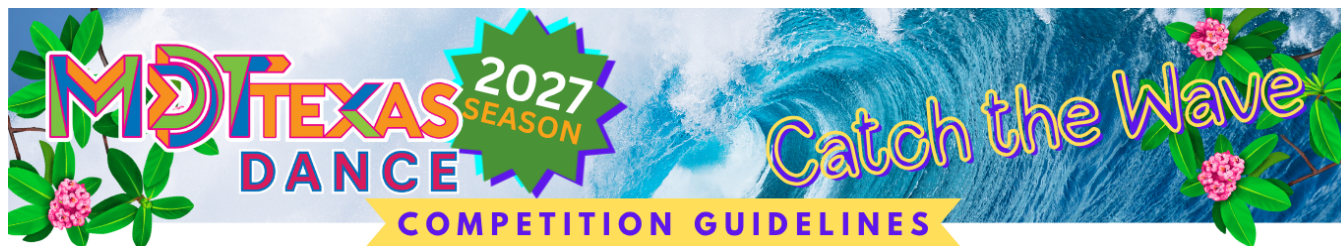

MUSIC SUBMISSION

<< MUSIC INFORMATION >>

MDDTTexas will email a link to upload music to Google Drive one week prior to the contest with specific instructions. **ONLY FOR BACKUP:** A team representative with backup music will be required at the sound table and should remain for the duration of the routine. Music played from an iPhone or iPad will require the following: Auto Lock Off / Passcode Off / Volume Up / Airplane Mode On (so music is not interrupted).

<< MUSIC CRITERIA >>

MDDTTexas runs a 4/5 Team and Officer schedule. If you have set-up time needed for your performance, please add let us know when completing registration in the proper location. Solo, duet, and trio performances will be scheduled every 3/4 minutes with some solo performances divided between the gym and auditorium.

<< MUSIC DURATION >>

Teams, Officers, Ensembles, and Solos: 1½-3:00 minutes in length.
Production/Open: 5 minutes in length. All music should be professionally recorded for the best sound quality at the correct performance tempo. The competition area sometimes **WILL NOT** have WiFi capability. Please be sure you have a backup Internet connection. Lastly, MDDTTexas nor the Host School or Sound Company will be held responsible for audio devices not picked up following performances.

<< MUSIC RECORDINGS >>

For registration to be complete, you must **VERIFY** by agreeing to our Terms & Conditions that your music selection(s) have been purchased legally and have not been altered in any way to violate music copyright laws. By agreeing to our Terms and Conditions, you hold harmless MDDTTexas-DanceSurge from being liable should you be in violation of any copyright laws.
