 think we can support properly.
- A.T.E/ Speech and language therapists also reserves the right to ask that parents remove a child if his / her behaviour is putting other children, staff or him/her self at risk. In such cases collection from the centre would be the responsibility of, and at the expense of the parent or guardian who signed the application. It is in nobody's interest (least of all the child's) to send someone to the 'Talking out' course who is likely to be unacceptably disruptive or aggressive.
