FINANCIAL REPORT:

3. Carolyn, Nancy, Debbie to work on supporting pages for presentation and folder to leave with prospect. Tiers discussed were Platinum \$1K plus, Gold \$750, Silver \$500, Bronze \$250. We need to decide that what they get within each tier. In the presentation packet we need info on where our \$ goes, # FB followers, sheet on our partnership with county making us only horse and hike for 20 years and maybe info on our board members bios showing our business experience, etc. Come up with pocket folder for presentation.

2. SIGNS— Nancy presented samples of what trail markers would look like. Nancy and Michael to come up with symbols, style, placement and type of sign and then we will test on a trail and see how it works. Keep all consistent with Ellen’s color legend and uniform in color, type, symbols.
3. Nancy—New trails that need to be market; Rim Valley Loop, Mtn. Ridge, Grulla
4. Charline--Cowboy Curtain plastic is to be replaced with plastic chains.
5. Charline—Huge Tree down on Palomino. She to contact Adam.



6. Charline—Canyon needs to be widened and fixed.
7. Debbie--Charline—we need to talk to county about tree removal on trails to allow UTV passage.
8. We discussed tying ribbons around trees that need to be removed due to encroachment and are now impeding access for emergency UTV's.
9. Charline--Obstacles—list and cost of repairs. Budgeted \$1K max.

13. Bill: Need highline at Palomino.
