Section Comments

For Real time PCR result Interpretation/ Explanation and Recommendation:

• Detected (Ct value ≤ 37.0): Reaction indicative of the presence of target nucleic acid. The lower the Ct value, the higher the amounts of nucleic acid present in the sample.

• Inconclusive (Ct value 37.1-40.0): Weak reaction which could represent early or late infection, residual vaccine or environmental contamination. Follow up testing is recommended.

• Not Detected (Ct value 0): No detection of the target nucleic acid.

• Indeterminate (with no Ct value): This result is specific for MAP PCR when reaction was observed from only one of the 3 PCR targets or the IS900 target did not show a reaction. This can be indicative of other Mycobacterium or nonspecific reactivity. A follow up MAP PCR or fecal culture is recommended.
