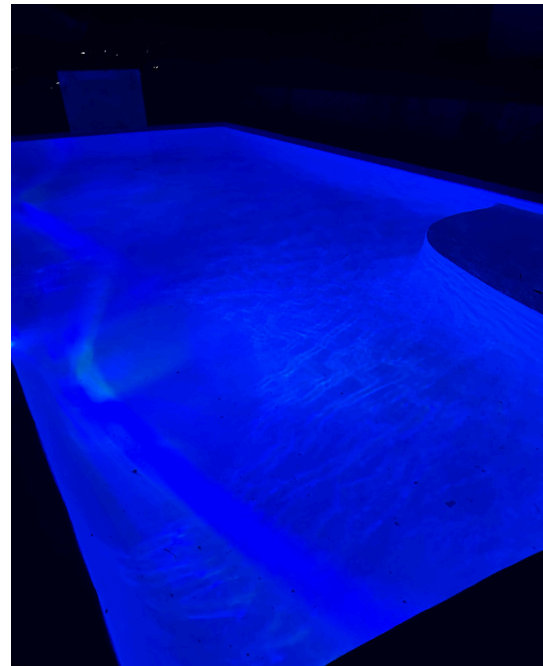

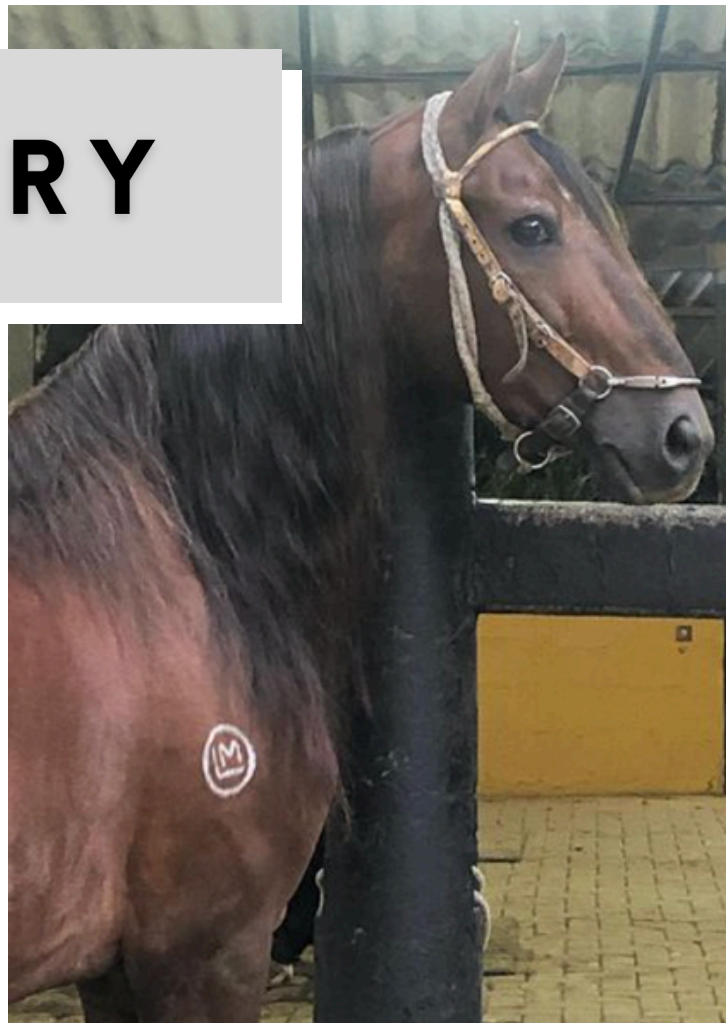
The **best view** by far however is on New Years Eve when dozens of cities fill the night sky with hundreds of fireworks!

OUR HISTORY

Thank you for choosing Villa Vista in Carolina, Puerto Rico as your destination for your vacation. This property was discovered back in 2021 by a real estate entrepreneur and visionary by the name of Roberto Green who located this property on a Craigslist ad.

After much negotiations and relationship building with the original owner, Roberto was able to take over this abandoned property and fully renovate it to what you see it as today.



As you will note this property sits over 2 acres of land which was once a training ground for some of the most prestigious Paso Fino horses in Puerto Rico. This ranch would hold between 30-40 horses at a time with over 20 stables.

Prior owner, Fundador "Daddy" Diaz, who passed away 3 months after the sale of the property in 2023 was a well known horse trainer and businessman who raised and trained these horses for Paso Fino.

Paso Fino was a traditional style of riding horses developed in Puerto Rico in which the horses have a smooth, natural, four-beat, lateral gait. Highly popular on Puerto Rican ranches and farms, Paso Fino horses were prized for their soothing ride, agile speed, and ability to travel long distances comfortably over mountainous island terrain while still being suitable for ranch work and cattle handling.

Famous Puerto Rican boxer, Tito Trinidad, was also known to have purchased his horses from this ranch. Even the most expensive horse in the world, Joyero, who originated in Colombia would roam this land prior to partaking in competitions held in Puerto Rico.



ABOUT PUERTO RICO

Puerto Rico is a beautiful island in the northeastern Caribbean known for its stunning beaches, mountainous interior, and vibrant culture. You'll find yourself spoiled for choice when it comes to beaches like Flamenco Beach in Culebra and iconic surf towns like Rincón. The island's interior is extremely diverse, ranging from the towering karst hills in the north to the rugged Luquillo Mountains in El Yunque National Forest. The unique geography makes for endless adventures - from snorkeling the coral reefs in the south to hiking through misty cloud forests in the central peaks.

Yet it's the culture that truly gives Puerto Rico its energetic identity. Spend time wandering colorful colonial Old San Juan, enjoying nightlife along the beachfront boardwalks, and savoring flavors from traditional mofongo mash to local rums and tropical cuisine. 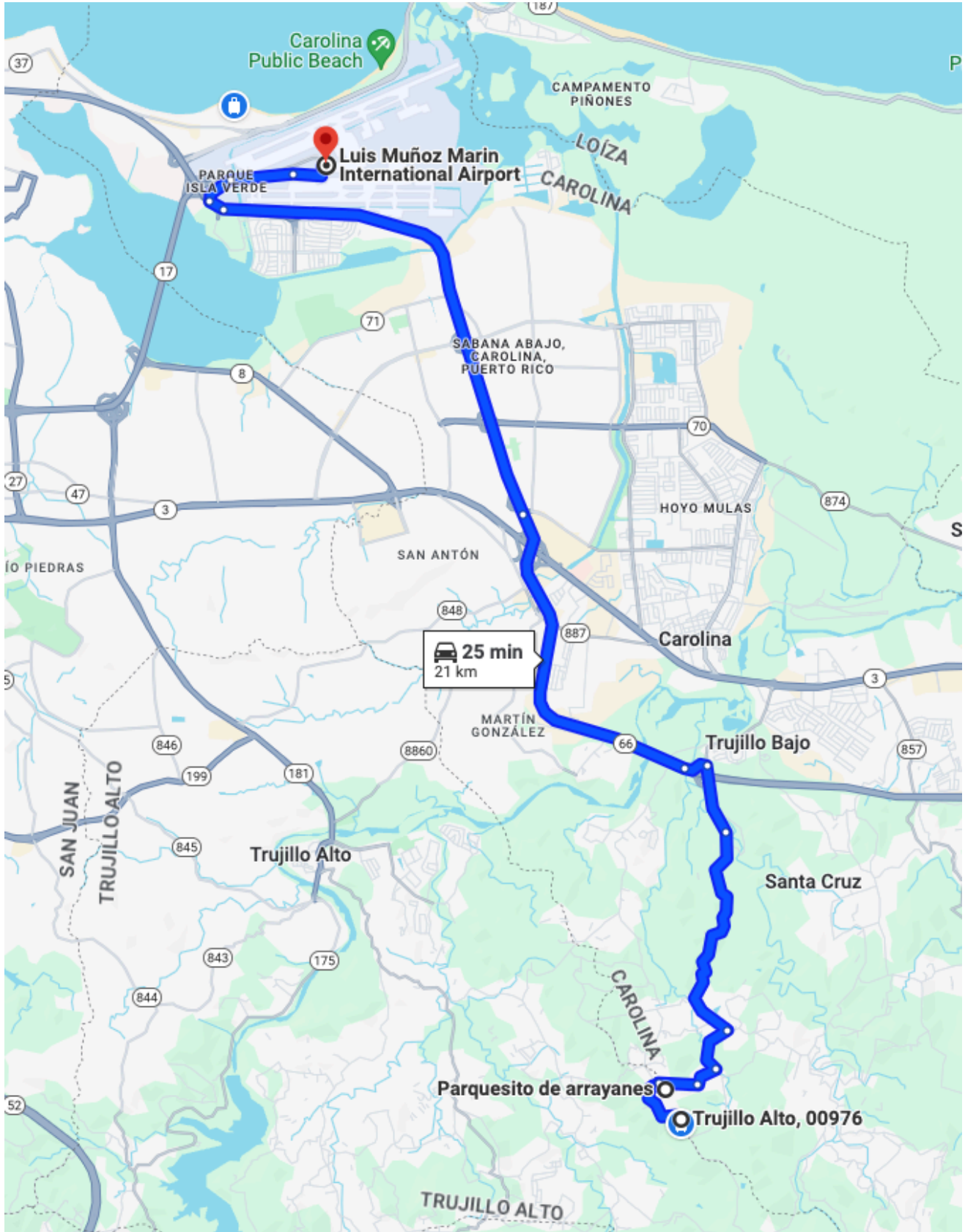

- **Welcome to Puerto Rico!**
- Take **Airport Rd** to Expreso Román Baldorioty de Castro/PR-26
- Take the **Carolina exit** on your right
- Head towards **26 Este- Ave. Los Angeles, Carolina, Fajardo**
- Continue towards **26 Oeste Carolina, Canovanas, Fajardo**
- Continue towards **66 Este Canovanas Fajardo**
- Go through the EZPass tolls
- Take a **right on Exit 5** that reads **Salida 5 Carolina, Barrazas, Carruzos**
- Take a **right at the stop sign** that reads **Carruzos, Barrazas, Guanabo ----->**
- Keep straight until you see the **yellow Villa Vista sign** on your right hand side and **take that right**
- After passing over a small bridge you will eventually see a white church and another **Yellow Villa Vista Arrow** on your left hand side pointing up. **Take that right up the hill**
- **Do not go straight into the Dead End Road** as you will have to return back to the church and take a left up the hill.
- Continue to go up the hill until you see another **Yellow Villa Vista Arrow** where you will take a left and then immediate right
- Continue through the path until you go through one last hill upwards in which you will see our Villa on your **left hand side**
- **Welcome to Villa Vista!**

Driving Tips

TO VILLA VISTA

We have driven to and from the Villa dozens of times at this point and have come up with the below tips to give you the best experience possible!

- We recommend driving in **mid-sized sedans, SUVs, Jeeps, trucks or vans**
- **Take your time and enjoy** the views as you go up the hills
- **Drive on your far right side** as the streets are narrow and they are two-way
- **Use your high beams** at night if you feel it is too dark in certain areas
- **Drive slowly and precautiously** when it rains (*10-15mph*)
- **Do not drink and drive** (*this goes without saying*)

Getting around & PARKING

There are a variety of ways to get around the local town, including areas you can walk to, as well as public transport options such as Uber and scooters



AIRPORT

Please book your flight to the **Luis Muñoz Marín International Airport (SJU)** as it is the closest airport to the Villa (25min)

CAR RENTAL

Renting a reliable car will be required to gain access to the Villa as it is in an elevated area just 25min away from the city.

UBER

Uber is available on the island however do not depend on an Uber to arrive to the Villa.

You will need to rent a vehicle

SCOOTERS

Some local towns such as Old San Juan have access to electric scooters that you can rent per hour to enjoy scenic views of the city

Here are some of the major car rental companies located near the **Luis Muñoz Marín International Airport (SJU)** in San Juan, Puerto Rico:

Avis - Has an office located in the airport terminal for convenient rentals when you land.

Budget - Also has a rental counter inside the SJU airport. Budget is known for competitive pricing.

Hertz - Major international company with a Puerto Rico rental branch situated right at the airport.

Enterprise - There are multiple Enterprise rental locations off-airport but close by in the Carolina area, about a 10 minute drive from the terminals. Provides free customer shuttle.

Sixt - Another large rental car provider with an outlet onsite at the airport terminal area. Known for luxury and sports vehicle offerings.

Thrifty, Dollar, Alamo - These popular rental car brands also have rental counters located right in the airport. Easy to pick up your vehicle quickly when you land in San Juan.

So in summary, you'll find all the major rental car companies available on location when you arrive at the main San Juan International Airport to start your travels around Puerto Rico.

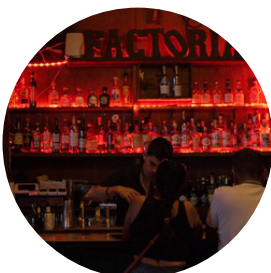

1 FLY TO SJU

The Luis Muñoz Marin International Airport is 25min away from the Villa (SJU)

2 PLAN AHEAD

3 RENT A CAR

We are located in an elevated area with steep hills so be sure to rent a reliable vehicle such as a mid-sized car, SUV, Jeep or Van

4 BUY GROCERIES

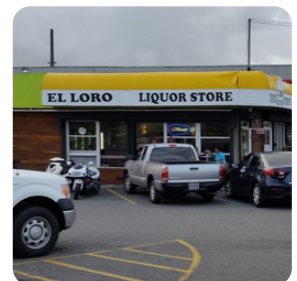
If for any reason you need to make a run to the pharmacy, there is a Walgreens pharmacy within a 20 minute driving distance where you can get your off the counter medications.
