## **ODF Sponsors Hunter Safety Instructor Certification Class**

On March 23<sup>rd</sup> ODF hosted, at the clubhouse, a Certification Class for adults wanting to become a Hunter Safety instructor. The class was put on by the DNR training team from Eau Claire. Linda Xiong from the DNR was the lead instructor coordinating the event for us.

We had 11 local participants plus some additional attendees from around the state. Hunter Safety classes for kids and adults are something ODF has hosted in the past. With Covid, the classes have fallen by the wayside in recent years. The instructor class is an effort to get a group of local certified instructors so we can resurrect the general Hunter Safety class. ODF views offering Hunter Safety classes as part of our youth and conservation mission.

The expectation is for ODF to offer Hunter Safety classes this summer or early fall. If you were born after January 1<sup>st</sup>, 1973 you are required to have Hunter Safety certification in order to hunt in the State of Wisconsin. #### **Youth Committee Report**

Students from Lemonweir Academy in the Mauston School District tapped maple trees on the Lemonweir Farm to collect sap and make maple syrup. The sap was running early this year and this activity occurred in February. This was the first time for the students and some of the teachers so everyone learned from the experience. Outdoors Forever was grateful for this opportunity to partner with the Mauston School District to help the students experience a memorable outdoor adventure!

#### **Kids Day**

The annual Kids Outdoor Day will be held at the Lemonweir Farm on Saturday April 27 from 9:00 am-12:00PM. The kids will learn archery skills, learn about pollinator habitat, how the plant a tree, build a bird house, and look for shed antlers. Each kid can take home a bird house and a spruce tree. Lunch will be provided.

#### Larson Road Habitat Project

Outdoors Forever habitat committee has been working with the USDA to set up food plots and pollinator seedings, on this 20 acre field. This will start in the year 2025, as the field has been rented for 2024. This will be a 10 year, 11 month commitment. There will be 4 food plots of one acre each and a hedgerow of 1 acre, consisting of high bush cranberries, dog wood and ninebark. This will be a great addition to the Duffy Road land and will become a pheasant and quail haven.

#### The Men's Shed

Since the kick-off in August of 2022, The Juneau County Men's Shed has continued to grow, create both community and personal connections for attendees as well as offer a place that attendees look forward to coming to. Each month offers another opportunity for attendees to learn from local talent, share in conversation, laughter and of course a meal! The ADRC of Juneau County has been grateful for the partnerships that have made The Men's Shed possible. Many thanks are extended to Outdoors Forever Conservation Club as well as the Juneau County Land and Water Department.

Not only has the average attendance at the monthly Men's Shed events grown from an average of 25 to 60, but many attendees have reported to have created new connections to other community groups, services and resources. #### Habitat

OUTDOORS FOREVER members Jeff Scully, Dave Laridaen and Bill Taylor were recycling Christmas trees to be used for habitat. The trees were placed along the hedge row on the County road N property. They will be used for winter cover for pheasant, quail, rabbits and song birds.

The heavy wet snow took a toll on our pheasant pens this past winter. Much work will need to be done before the pheasants are put into the large runs.

#### **Pheasant Program Update**

This winter was mild in temperature generally speaking but we did still get hit with one large storm carrying wet heavy snow. That storm damaged the pens but not quite to the same extent as last years winter storms. With that being said, repairs are under way and anyone who's willing to help would certainly be put to work. Work days are Wednesday afternoons starting around 3:30. Beginning work days earlier in the year gives us the opportunity to put up flight netting without

having too much grass growing through it. The crew has already taken down an entire net and will soon begin hanging the new ones! We have a couple upgrades we would like to make this year to help improve life for the pheasants at the pens and reduce the physical labor needed to maintain things. As spring progresses we will continue to prepare for the chicks which will be arriving in June. I'm also excited to say that there has been numerous reports of pheasant sightings around the area meaning some of the birds from last year made it through the winter. We are looking forward to raising another batch of birds and hope that continued habitat improvements on the landscape combined with healthy birds will benefit the area for many years to come. ## **Trout Rearing Program**

The trout that arrived past mid July were approximately 3" long. At the end of this March trout are looking good! With what's been observed, lengths are 9-11". There's over a month to go with the feeding, done daily, thank you to Rick Dogs.

The trout will be stocked in the Outdoors Forever fishing pond on Meyer Rd just outside of Mauston , before the opening of trout season, May 4th.

DNR rules are in place for fishing trout there.

#### **Stewards to Sportsman**

We welcome youth hunters as well as novice hunters to experience a hands on, interactive opportunity to get out and participate in both duck and goose hunting. # **Duffy Road Trout Stream Project Update**

On March 6, 2024 Jennifer Bergman and Dustin Ladd from the DNR met with Dave Puhl, Dave Laridaen, Paul Brown and Jeff Scully from ODF at the Duffy Road property and discussed some of the concerns of the two groups with the project. After great collaboration and a bit of negotiation we came together to move the project forward, deciding that we need to build at least 2 more wood structures and 2 more rock ripples in the stream and remove the beaver dams and potentially the beaver den. In the early months of summer we should see some progress and hopefully the completion of this project. In the end we may have some shrubs and shorter trees along the stream bank for erosion control and stream temperature stabilization. Below are some pictures of one of at lease 5 unlucky beavers that we evicted and collaboration photos of the group walking the stream. You might not see them in the pictures but yes there were trout in the stream!!


