

Use of Bouncy Castles

Bouncy castles, are only permitted INSIDE the Community Centre and must be suitable for indoor use (maximum height 2.8m and with protective matting). The Community Association does not provide any insurance for the use of bouncy castles and cannot accept any responsibility whatsoever in the event of any accident. It is the responsibility of the hirer to make sure that the supplier has public liability insurance.

When booking, the hirer must state on the booking form that they intend to have a bouncy castle, and the hirer must provide the Management Committee with a copy of the liability insurance before the hire date. The Management Committee reserves the right to prohibit the use of the bouncy castle, or to cancel the booking if appropriate evidence is not provided on request.

Should any damage be caused to the Community Centre fixture and fittings (ie: flooring, lights etc.) by the use of a Bouncy Castle, the cost of damage will be retained from the hirers deposit and if greater than the deposit the balance sought from the hirer.

Hire of the Community Centre does not include exclusive use of the field to the rear. If you wish to use a bouncy castle or any other form of play equipment on the field, permission must be first obtained from the Parish Council clerk via email: clerkstokehammondpc@gmail.com A copy of the liability insurance and safety inspection certificate must be provided to the Parish Council clerk before the hire date.

It is the hirers responsibility to ensure that:

- The bouncy castle is inflated by the supplier
- All guidance and instructions given by the supplier must be followed at all times
- A supervising adult must be in attendance throughout its use to monitor the children
- The number of children using the bouncy castle must be limited to the number recommended in the Hire Company's safety instructions.
- All children must be made to remove footwear, hard or sharp objects such as jewellery, buckles, pens and other similar pocket contents.
- Eating and drinking while bouncing or performing acrobatics must not be allowed.
