....LONNA'S DUMP CAKE RECIPE....

INGREDIENTS: 1 CAN CRUSHED PINEAPPLE
1 CAN CHERRY PIE FILLING
1 YELLOW CAKE MIX
CHOPPED WALNUTS TO TASTE
SHREDDED COCONUT TO TASTE

INSTRUCTIONS:

MIX PINEAPPLE & CHERRY FILLING TOGETHER IN 8x12 PAN.

MELT 1½ STICKS OF MARGARINE. POUR OVER TOP. BAKE AT 350 DEGREES 35 MINUTES OR UNTIL TOOTHPICK COMES OUT CLEAN.

- (1) ONE #303 CAN PINEAPPLE (UNDRAINED) SPREAD IN PAN BOTTOM.
- (2) ONE CAN PIE FILLING NEXT.
- (3) SPRINKLE DRY CAKE MIX.
- (4) 2 STICKS MARGARINE (CUT IN SMALL PIECES).
- (5) TOP WITH NUTS.
- (6) BAKE AT 350 DEGREES 55 TO 60 MINUTES IN 9x13 PAN.

OCTOBER SPEAKER:

WE WERE FORTUNATE TO HAVE A REALLY GOOD SPEAKER ON OCTOBER 9TH. THIS GENTLEMAN REPRESENTING THE FLORIDA FOSSIL HUNTERS GAVE A AUDIO-VISUAL PRESENTATION ON FINDS REPRESENTATIVE OF FLORIDA DINOSAURS, SHELLS, ET CETERA THAT DATED IN SOME CASES 35 MILLION YEARS AGO. AREAS OF DISCOVERY INCLUDED THE PANHANDLE, ST. PETERSBURG, GAINESVILLE, ARCADIA, QUINCY, AND THE STATES OF MONTANA, UTAH, AND COLORADO. 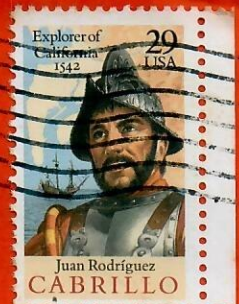
