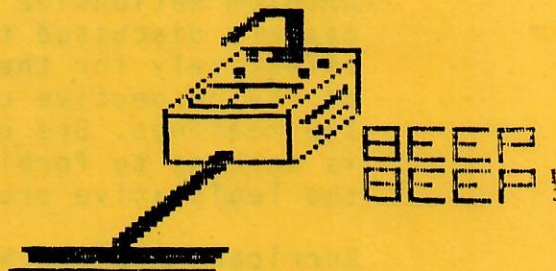

Single Coin: David Gascoyne won with a unique 1834 Dime.

Group Coins: Herb Phillips continues his winning ways with this collection. For starters there are: 1820 Large Cent; 1847 Large Cent; 1920 Half Dollar; 1894 Quarter; 2 Un-dated Standing Liberty Quarters; 7 Washington Quarters; 4 Barber Dimes dated 1892, 1901, 1906 & 1906; 5 Mercury Dimes; 3 Roosevelt Dimes; 2 War Nickels; 1890 "V" Nickel; 1 Canadian Dollar, and 1 Newport Bridge Token buried 4 inches. Herb lets us know that all the Barber coins, the two large cents, Barber 25¢ War Nickels, V Nickel, and 2 Mercuries were found around two churches and two old houses in New Sharon, Maine. The 1920 Half was behind a local library built in the late 1800's. Others were found in school yards and ski-slopes. The two Standing Liberty Quarters were discovered in the same hole at an old one-room school house unused for many years.

- .Catsup, Mustard, Relish, Chopped Onions, Plates, Utensils, Cups, Unsweetened Tea and Dessert!

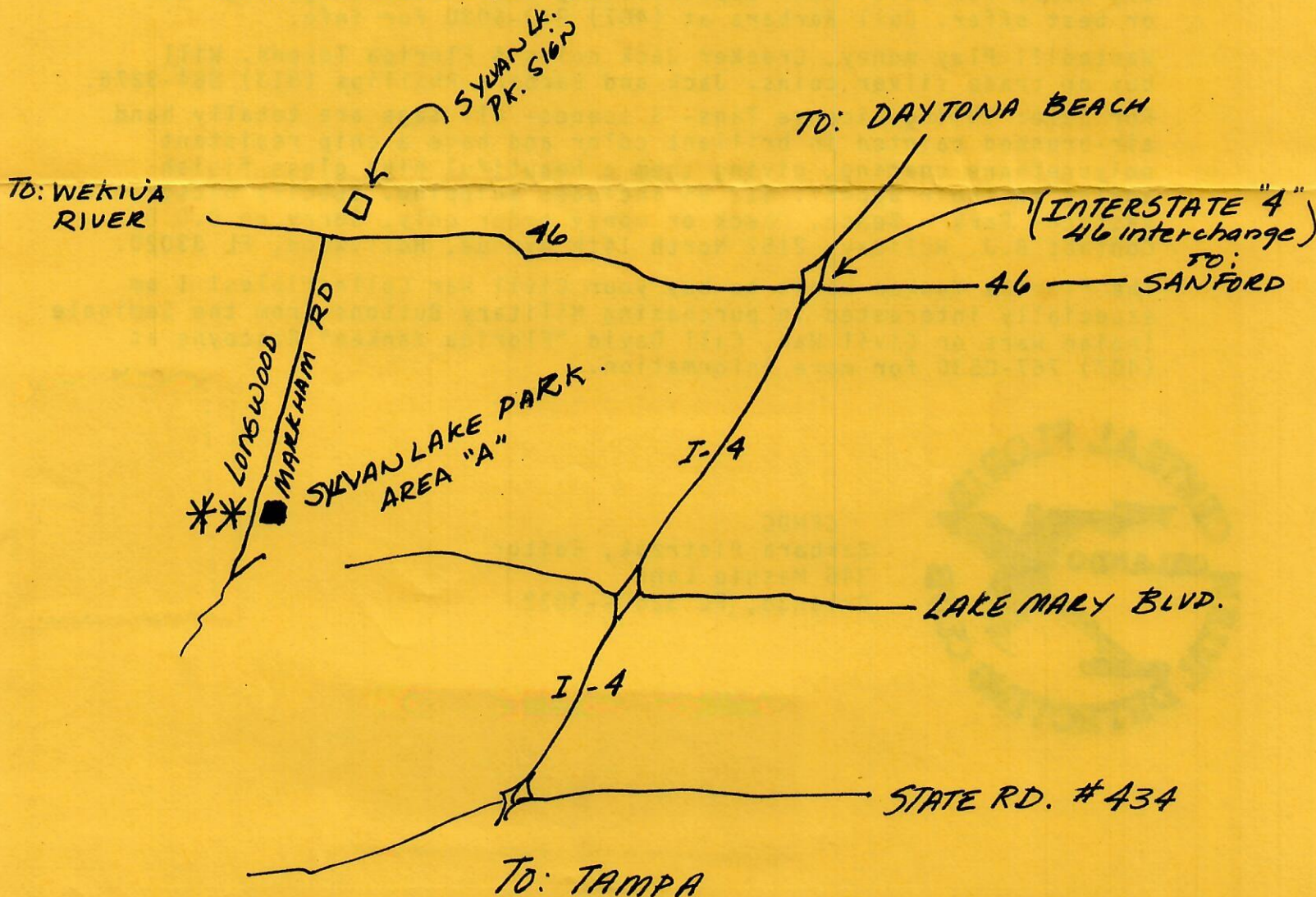
