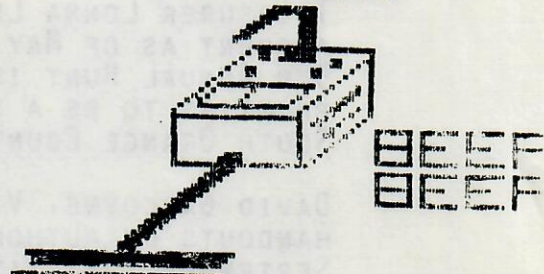

DAVID GASCOYNE, VICE-PRESIDENT SPOKE ON MILITARY BUTTONS. DAVID HAD HANDOUTS OF AUTHOR ED WILLIAMSON'S ARTICLE IN TREASURE FACTS, AUGUST/SEPTEMBER 1992 TITLED IDENTIFICATION OF UNITED STATES ARMY UNIFORM BUTTONS: PART I (1800 TO 1851); PART II (1851 TO 1872, OCTOBER/NOVEMBER 1992, AND PART III ON BUTTONS OF THE CONFEDERATE ARMY IN THE DECEMBER/JANUARY 1993 FOR REFERENCE.

SOME OF THE EARLIEST BUTTONS WERE WORN BY THE REGIMENT OF RIFLEMEN WHO WERE ORGANIZED IN 1808. THESE WERE IDENTIFIED BY THE SCRIPT "RR" ON A COAT-SIZED BUTTON, AND WERE LIKE THE DRAGOONS EXCEPT FOR ONE THING. THEY WERE DEPENDENT ON THE HORSE FOR TRANSPORTATION, BUT FOUGHT THEIR BATTLES "DISMOUNTED." LIKE THE DRAGOONS WHO WERE THE MOUNTED FIGHTING FORCE THEY WERE THE FORERUNNER OF THE CALVARY WHICH WAS OFFICIALLY ESTABLISHED IN 1855.

BUTTONS MAY HAVE BEEN IN ONE-PIECE, CAST METAL, WITH OR WITHOUT A BACKMARK, FOUND BY DIGGING OR IN LANGUAGE PARLANCE, A NON-DUG FIND! VALUES OF BUTTONS ARE FOUND IN THE NORTH SOUTH TRADER'S (NST) CIVIL WAR MAGAZINE'S 5TH EDITION OF THE CIVIL WAR COLLECTOR'S PRICE GUIDE FOR CIVIL WAR BUTTONS. THERE ARE 2 OTHER REFERENCES LISTED BUT THESE ARE DATED AND SPECIALIZED. NONETHELESS, THE SUBJECT IS AN ENDLESS, FASCINATING AND UTILITARIAN SUBJECT THAT DESERVES MORE THAN PASSING ATTENTION BY THE HOBBY AS IT IS A SPECIALIZED, REWARDING TRIP BACK IN TIME!
