SINGLE ARTIFACT: DAVID GASCOYNE FOUND AT FT. REID AN 1830 GREAT COAT BUTTON.

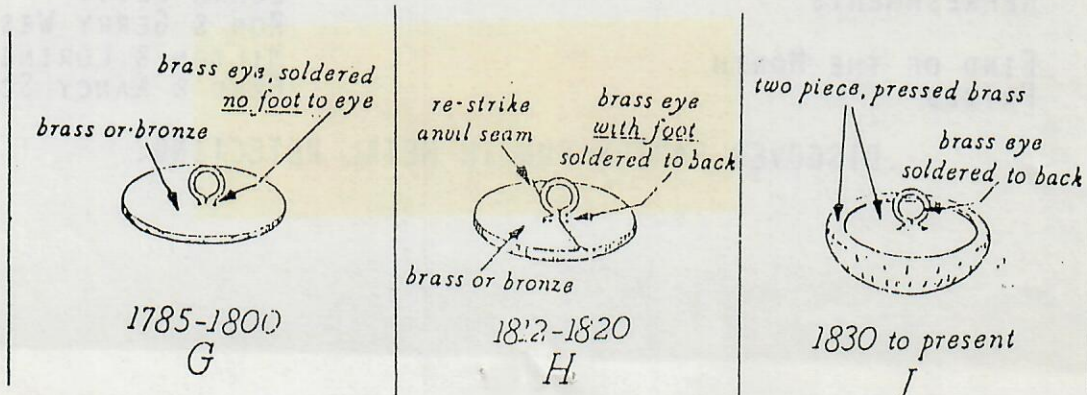
