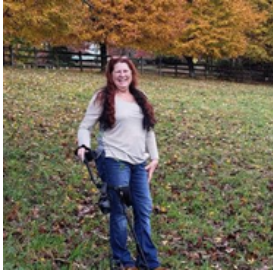
With the year coming up to an end pretty quick, I need everyone to start thinking about volunteering to be on the board, do tickets, make coffee and

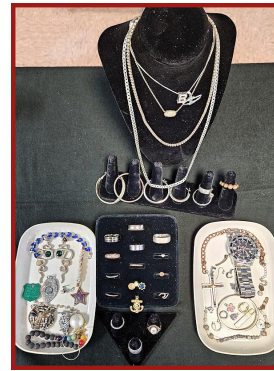

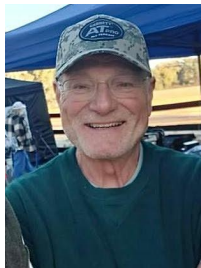
