RANDOM GOLD FACTS

Is bullion always pure gold ?

No. The American Eagle, Krugerrand, and Britannia, and others are 91.7% (22 karat) gold. They contain their full stated weight in gold, just like any form of bullion, but have an additional weight in alloy to harden them against wear. Other bullion coins are pure gold (24 karat or 99.99%) without alloy, including the Maple Leaf, Kangaroo, Panda, and Australian Dragon.
