Asked the volunteers for the Boy Scouts event to show up at Camp La-No-Che by 8am on Oct. 19.

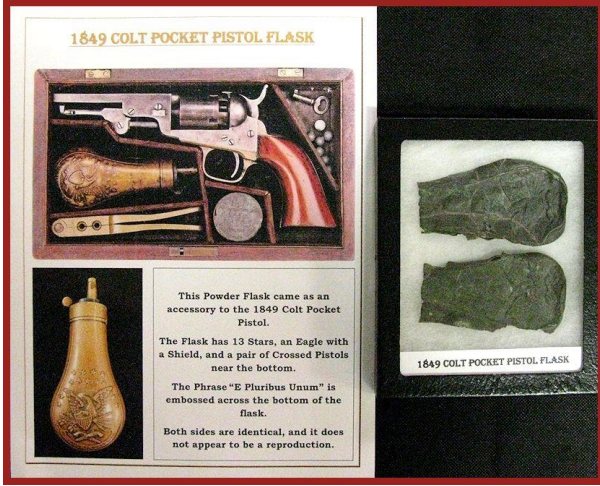

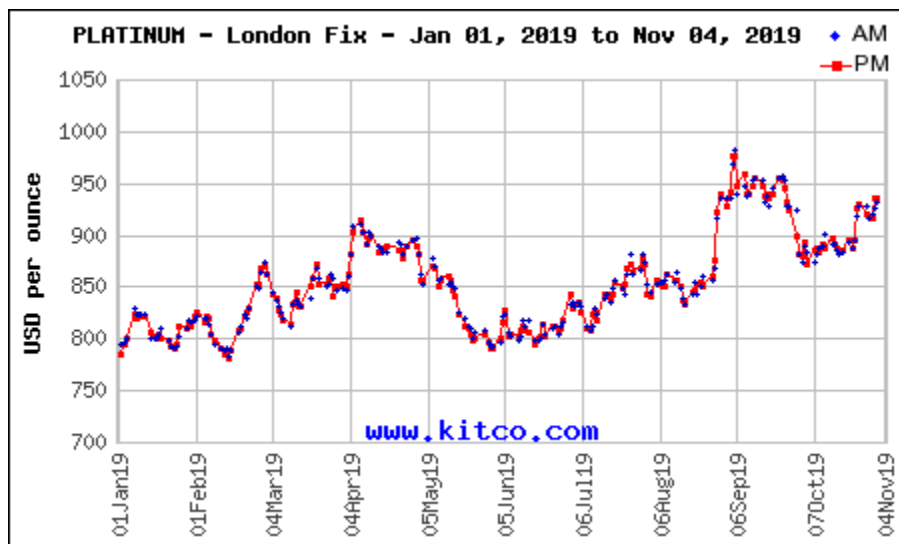

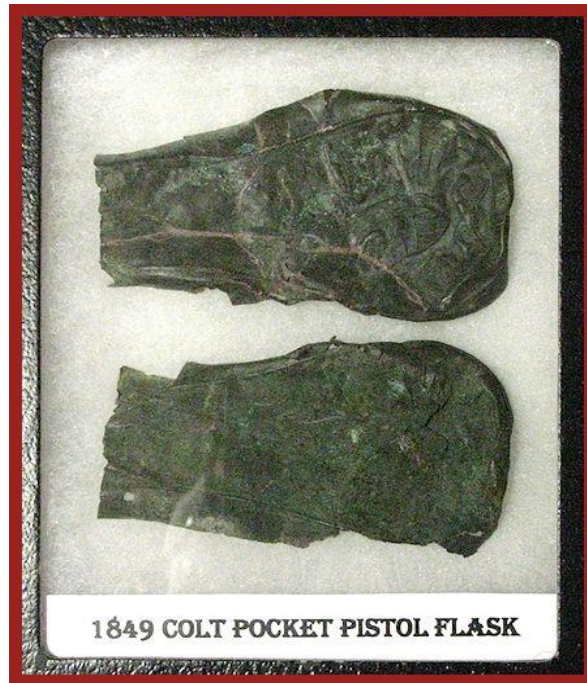
