Legal Status of The Tomlinson Association

The Tomlinson Association has officially been awarded its 501 (c) 7 from the Internal Revenue Services (IRS). Congratulations and a huge thanks to all who were involved with obtaining legal status for our family organization. So, what does it mean to be a 501 (c) 7, you ask? The Tomlinson Association is now recognized as a social club. A social club must be organized for pleasure, recreation, and other similar purposes and direct most of its income to the club's exempt purposes in order to remain tax exempt.

As a 501 (c) 7, we are exempt from federal income tax however, state and local exemption may vary. We can request exemption from state and local taxes, but each state has its own regulations regarding tax exemptions for nonprofits. Unfortunately, under our subsection of exemption, donors cannot deduct contributions they make to The Tomlinson Association.

The Tomlinson Family Reunion is now an activity of The Tomlinson Association. As a social club, we can establish other activities (e.g., Portia Tomlinson Scholarship Fund) under our Association and seek funding as a non-profit organization to support those activities. More details about our status will be discussed during upcoming business meetings.
