

Summertime of Wight

Built in 1965 at W.A. Souter Cowes, Isle of Wight, UK

Designed by Raymond Wall for Sir Peter Johnson of the Royal Ocean Racing Club as an offshore racer to race under the RORC rules.

It was no longer competitive when the new IOR rules were introduced & was sold.

The new owner converted the interior to make it more comfortable for cruising & sailed across the Atlantic through the Panama canal to Hawaii & then to Victoria BC. It was owned for 30 years by a local couple until 2013 when the present owner bought her & did extensive renovation work including replacing the engine with a Sole Mini-29
