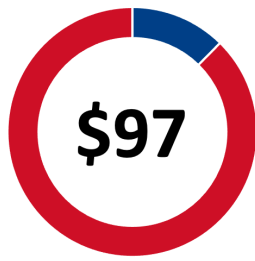

COST OF SCOUTING



BSA YOUTH REGISTRATION

- \$85 = National Membership Fee
- \$12 = Longhorn Council Insurance Fee
- *Assessed by National BSA every 12 months.*

PACK 435 PROGRAM DUES

- \$40 = Scout Advancement and Awards
- \$55 = Pack Program and Activities
- \$5 = Contingency Fund
- *Assessed by Pack 435 each August.*

All members must be fully paid to remain in Scouting.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: Do I have to register to participate?

A: Children must register in Scouting. Adults participate for free unless they are leaders.

Q: What do I need to bring to my first meeting?

A: Nothing. Just show up and have fun. Tell us you're new and we'll help you feel welcome.

Q: What if I joined midyear? Does the cost change?

A: National registration is due every 12 months from join. Pack dues will be prorated.

Q: There are lots of new terms. How hard is this to learn?

A: Don't worry! We've all been new. Scouting offers many opportunities for learning.

Q: Do you allow boys and girls?

A: Yes. Pack 435 welcomes all youth from ages 5 to 10.

Q: My child is also in another activity. Can I do both without missing out?

A: Absolutely! Most advancement can easily be made up with family outside meetings.
