- Has many original ideas
- Is very busy and productive
- Solves problems in unique ways

- Thinks divergently
- Adapts objects for new purposes
- Combines information from different sources into original ideas

INDEPENDENCE

- Prefers to do things her/his own way
- Marches to a different drummer
- Is goal-oriented with self-chosen projects
- Is happy to challenge conventions
- Is self-aware and reflective
- Likes to figure things out on his/her own
- Enjoys independent play
- Expresses strong preferences and ideas

LANGUAGE

- Has an advanced vocabulary
- Holds adult-like conversations
- Has a strong interest in books and reading
- Has strong negotiation skills
- Tells long involved stories with clear narrative flow
- Has excellent receptive language
- Has a mature sense of humor
- Communicates ideas effectively
- Speaks more than one language

ABSTRACT THINKING

- Is interested in abstract ideas, such as time, life and death, religion/spirituality
- Has strong spatial-visual skills (ex., enjoys mazes, Legos, blocks)
- Perceives patterns, connections, and relationships
- Enjoys numbers, puzzles, clocks, and/or calendars
- Makes logical arguments
- Enjoys planning and problem solving
- Asks deep questions
- Is concerned with justice
- Understands complex ideas

PERSISTENCE

- Focuses intently on one topic
- Persists at mastering new skills
- Has a long attention span for self-directed activities
- Pursues own interests over a long period of time
- Changes topics frequently, but concentrates on each one in turn
- Has a hard time with transitions when absorbed in an activity
- Masters new skills through observation and mental practice (with no outward practice)

MEMORY

- Learns things quickly
- Remembers things you didn't realize s/he knew
- Independently relates highly diverse ideas
- Absorbs general knowledge like a sponge
- Remembers things for much longer than would be expected

PRE-ACADEMIC SKILLS

- Knows most preschool basics: colors, numbers, letters, and shapes
- Learns many basic skills without practice or direct instruction
- Displays emergent academic skills (please list)
