Job Description:

Title: Independent LICSW

Job type: Contract

Responsible to: Clinical Director

Works with: Program Directors, Program Managers, Program Staff and Volunteers, Funders, Community Partners and Community Participants

Job Objective: The Social Worker provides direct care to client's and their families experiencing social and interpersonal adjustment problems caused or complicated by psychiatric and/or chemical dependency illness or disability. Performs psychosocial and family assessment, provides family therapy, participates in multidisciplinary treatment planning, collaborates with existing outpatient treatment teams including but not limited to: treating clinicians, DMH case-workers, and DSS case-workers, etc. Develops comprehensive aftercare/disposition plans, and when caseload permits, provides group therapy. Outpatient services are dedicated to helping women overcome trauma, and substance dependence and empowering them to achieve productive and drug-free lives.

General Responsibilities:

- Provide woman-centered and trauma informed DV, SUD's and mental health treatment
- Provide individual, family and or group therapy
- Provides diagnosis and discusses treatment plan with patients.
- Build a client base.
- Completes and creates a database for client intake notes and safeguards client confidentiality
- Practices clean needle technique.
- Follows up on license renewals and seeks ongoing education.
- Works in collaboration with multi-disciplinary team to perform clinical assessments and develop treatment plans. The wellness team includes mental health therapists, PRN, peer leaders, yoga and meditation instructors, massage therapists etc.

Qualifications:

- Graduate of an accredited school of social work.
- Current licensure, LCSW or LICSW, in the state of Massachusetts.

- Proven interpersonal and organizational skills, as well as the ability to function as a team member.
- Demonstrated knowledge of all treatment services available, and treatment and discharge planning
