**Job Description:**

**Title:** Supervising Physician

**Responsible to:** Program Director

**Job Type:** Contract position

**Works with:** Medical Staff, Program Directors, Program Managers, and Program Staff.

**Job Objective:** The Supervising Physician will be a crucial member of The Woman at the Well multidisciplinary care team. This position is responsible for supervising Psychiatric Nurse Practitioners within the boundaries of state and federal regulations and accreditation standards. The Woman at the Well will integrate mental health and substance use disorder treatment by offering a host of treatment services in a comfortable, safe and warm stress less environment.

**Duties:**

- Provides supervision to medical staff in the performance of medical services including prescribing and monitoring or supervising the prescription of all medications;
- Participate in case reviews as appropriate and provide case consultations as necessary
- Will be available by telephone when they're not at the facility and will be accessible working approximately 4 hours a week.

**Preferred Qualifications:**

- Medical Degree from accredited college/university. Currently licensed by the State Med Licensure Board, 3-5 years' experience in substance use treatment preferred; or familiarity with prescribing of mental health medications and medication assisted treatment, suboxone, naltrexone
- Requires self- direction, tact, diplomacy, and a clear, courteous and professional manner when working with staff members- team player.
- Must demonstrate effective oral and written communication skills, proficient time management skills;
- Willingness to work within a multidisciplinary team.
