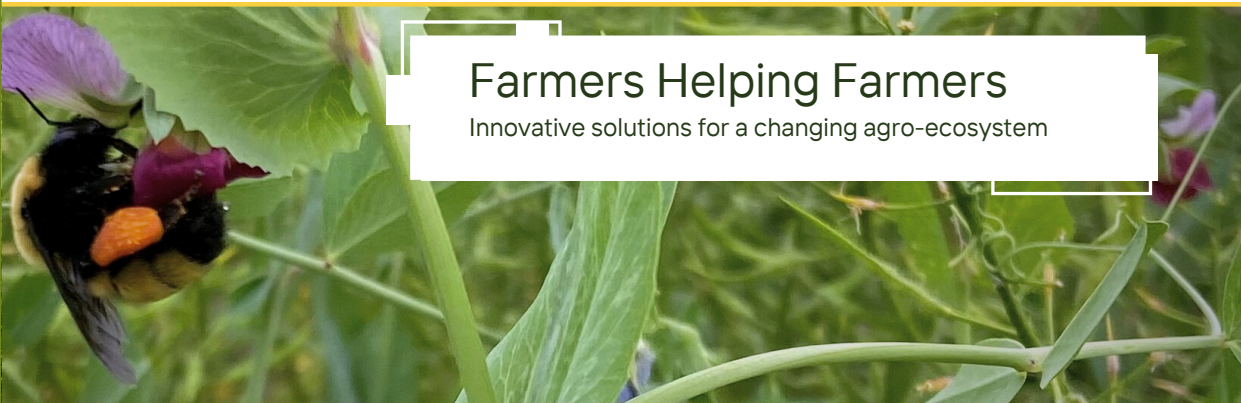

Trial Results Sneak Peek



The results are in from our trial underseeding red clover and annual ryegrass with durum. Both established well this year and we saw an increase in yield (and revenue) on the trial. Now in early October, both species are still actively growing and green - still nodulating and fixing nitrogen for the system to utilize next year. The plan is to graze at the end of the month, allow the biennial red clover to overwinter, and either graze again in the spring or kill remaining plants with burn off.
