 - IS groups: Revenue, Expenses, Salaries & Wages, Fringe, Transfers
 - Fringe pool (56509xx)
 - Not included in the reports from Payroll

OUTCOMES

- Total Department Expenses
- Total Department Revenue

OUTCOMES

- Semi-accurate
 - Best possible model with the available data
- Reliable
 - Allows accurate year-to-year or semester-to-semester comparisons
- Reproducibility

OUTCOMES

- Pending Improvements
 - Revenue by Major
 - Profitability
 - By Department
 - By Program
 - Faculty teaching load (students per professor)
 - Students per course

OUTCOMES

- Expansion
 - Can be performed in reverse
 - (B&E students taking classes in other Colleges)
 - Undergraduate/Graduate
 - Resident/Non-Resident
 - Application to other Colleges/DAs




CREDITS (by dept)






