Fast Facts

- 1 in 4 babies born two or more months premature may be diagnosed with Cerebral Palsy.
- Over the course of a lifetime it costs an individual with Cerebral Palsy over \$1 million for the equipment, therapy, medical care and lifestyle changes necessary to manage his or her disability
- Cerebral Palsy is the most common motor disability in children
- Footsteps of WNY focuses special attention on those individuals throughout the community that demonstrate a financial need.
- As a volunteer only organization, nearly 100% of what is donated goes to assist the families and individuals we aim to serve.

- Since 2013 Footsteps of WNY has been able to fund over 1500 weeks of physical, occupational, and horse riding therapies to individuals in our community living with Cerebral Palsy.
- We have also been able to provide over \$200,000 in assisting devices and technology These items include, wheelchairs, adaptive bikes, and purposeful exercise equipment

Adapt-Able Sports Scholarships

Footsteps of WNY Adapt-ABLE sports and recreation scholarships provide financial support to individuals with Cerebral Palsy who want to try a new sport or build skills by attending camps, clinics, or other adaptive sports programs.

The Footsteps of WNY "Capes for Kids" program sends personalized handmade superhero capes to children with Cerebral Palsy who have had surgery or are doing physical or occupational therapy.

Every cape is crafted and hand-stitched by volunteers using donated supplies.
