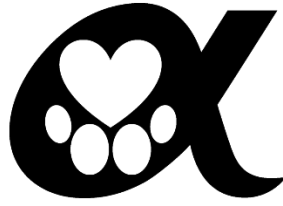

TRAINING VOCABULARY

Gesture	Command	Meaning
	COME	Come closer, you are a little too far (Non-urgent command)
	HERE! - Whistle	Come to me NOW! Whatever pet is doing should be stopped and come closer immediately.
	SIT	To sit
	DOWN	To lie down
	OKAY - GO PLAY	Release command, whatever pet has been told to do, they are now free.
-	OUT - OFF	To get feet off of whatever they are on (people, furniture, flower bed)
	HEEL	To walk along side on a loose leash rather than pulling
-	TAKE IT - GET IT	Whatever the pet's nose is in may be taken or go retrieve an object
-	INSIDE	Inside the house so I can close the door or inside the vehicle so I can put up the window.
	WAIT - STOP!	To wait where pet is until human gets closer and release command is given
-	SETTLE - ENOUGH!	Enough of whatever it is pet is doing (barking, playing tug, rough playing) or simply to settle the enthusiasm
-	MOVE IT	To move out of the way, usually used while walking or biking.
-	LEAVE IT	Whatever the pet's nose is in is to be left alone and they are to back off from the object
-	DROP IT – GIVE IT	Whatever the pet has on its mouth is to be dropped or given to the human and they are to back off from the object
-	GENTLE	When taking something from human's hand into pet's mouth or play softly
	STAY	To stay where pet was positioned until human returns to you and releases (assuming you're out of site)
