CHRISTMAS/NEW YEAR'S EVE

This holiday is split in two segments. The first segment begins at 9 AM following the last day of school and continues until December 25 at 6 PM. The second segment begins December 25 at 6 PM and concludes the day before school resumes.

SUMMER/QUAD BREAK VACATIONS

Each parent is entitled to one (1) vacation each year not to exceed a two (2) week period, unless there is an agreement in writing to the contrary, which writing would be non-modifiable by the court.

During the year in which a parent may select their vacation time first, failing to do so by the May 1st deadline will permit either parent to make plans via certified mail to the other parent. Vile earlier certified mail stamp will prevail as to the parent who made the earlier plans when there is a conflict in times.

## VISITATION SCHEDULE

1. Holiday and summer visitation schedule as set forth below:
  - a) Father will have the minor children on Martin Luther King Day, Memorial Day, Labor Day and Nevada Admissions Day (Halloween) in even numbered years; Mother will have the minor children on Martin Luther King Day, Memorial Day, Labor Day and Nevada Admissions Day (Halloween) in odd numbered years.
  - b) Father will have the minor children on President's Day, 4th of July, and Veteran's Day in odd numbered years; Mother will have the minor children on President's Day, 4th of July, and Veteran's Day in even numbered years.
  - c) Father will have the minor children during the children's Easter break from school through Easter Sunday at 5:00 p.m. in even numbered years; Mother will have the minor children during the children's Easter break from school through Easter Sunday at 5:00 p.m. in odd numbered years.
  - d) The Thanksgiving holiday shall begin on the Wednesday evening before Thanksgiving Day and continue through Sunday at 5:00 p.m. Father will have the minor children during the Thanksgiving holiday in even numbered years; Mother will have the minor children during the Thanksgiving holiday in odd numbered years.
  - e) Christmas will be divided into two equal periods. The first period will begin the day school lets out for Christmas break and will continue to December 25 at 12:00 noon. The second period will begin on December 25 at 1:00 p.m. and end on January 2 at 8:00 a.m. Mother will have the minor children during the first period in odd numbered years; Father will have the minor children during the second half in odd numbered years. Father will have the minor children during the first period in even numbered years; Mother will have the minor children during the second half in even numbered years.
  - f) That the parties will share the birthdays of the minor children each year.
  - g) Mother will have the children on Mother's Day and Mother's birthday.
  - h) Father will have the children on Father's Day and Father's birthday each year.
  - i) The children will reside with Father for four (4) weeks each summer. During that time, Mother shall have visitation with the minor children as follows:
    - (1) Alternating weekends beginning on Friday at 5:00 p.m. through Sunday at 6:00 p.m.
    - (2) Wednesday of each week to 8:00 p.m.

If either parent takes a summer vacation during the time they are otherwise entitled to have the children, the vacationing parent shall be entitled to have an uninterrupted vacation period with the children, not to exceed two consecutive weeks.
