So many opportunities to help with the ministry in Kenya.

As our mission trip to Kenya developed, we were able to establish the opportunities to help in evangelism and in the practical needs of two orphanages and a children's prison. Our relationship with Pastor Isaac Ondtiti in Kenya was firmly secured. The work God is using him in planting churches, training pastors, and running two orphanages and visiting a children's prison is amazing. You can help with this great work through WCC in a couple of ways.

1. Adopt a child at the orphanage for \$30 a month
2. Buy Bibles for the growing churches at \$10 a piece.
3. Donate funds to help in building of church buildings.
4. Donate \$\$ for bringing food, Bibles and mattresses for the children's prison (the government funding for the prison is extremely low).

All donations are tax deductible through WCC. Place your check in the offering plate or mail in a check and put the area God is prompting you to give in the memo area. Or go to our online giving portal on our website, under donation for... choose Foreign Missions and under Missionary name, choose the area you wish to give.

As Pastor of WCC, I see this as an opportunity for the Body of Christ in Wiggins to have an impact for God's Kingdom on a world-wide scale. Please pray about getting involved!
