
# The Word

As I work my way through the Psalms as part of my daily devotion, I have come to Psalm 91. This particular Psalms, as many do, lead me into a time of pause, meditating and prayer. So many wonderful truths found here. I will highlight just a few of these truth but let me suggest that you spend more than a few minutes, more than a few

days pondering and praying through all of the truths found in this Psalm. Vs. 3, "For it is He (God) who delivers you from the snare of the trapper and from the deadly pestilence."

We have no idea of the constant deliverance we have experienced. How many times has God protected you and your family from a car wreck, an abusive situation or an attack from Satan? How many ways has He protected your heart from falling for the lies of Satan? Most of the world around you is heading down the wide path to destruction but not you. God is protecting you, guiding you, blessing you in more ways than you will ever know.

Vs. 11, "For He (God) will give His angels charge concerning you, to guard you in all your ways. They will bear you in their hands, that you do not strike your foot against a stone." We have all heard about our guardian angel but according to this verse there are angels, plural, guarding you. O my, where would we be without our guardian angels protecting us? I shudder to think.

As we contemplate and believe in these truths, the following is true of you. Vs. 5-7, "You will not be afraid of the terror by night, or of the arrow that flies by day; of the pestilence that stalks in the darkness, or the destruction that lays waste at noon. A thousand may fall at your side and ten thousand at your right hand, *but* it shall not approach you!"

O my Lord and Savior, Vs. 1-2, "(I will) dwell in the shelter of the Most High, (I will) abide in the shadow of the Almighty! I will say to the Lord, "My fortress, My God, in whom I trust!"

# **WCC Board News**

The WCC Board met for its monthly meeting on July 2nd. The meeting was called to order on 6:48 PM by Gideon Oleari. All were in attendance minus Glen Gray and Donna Oleari.

Barbara Wilson was present from the Department of Human Services to give her perspective on day programs as WCC is looking to start a Christian Day Program when the Wiggins School District is off for school. Tracy Donaghy presented then on where WCC is at in the Christian Day Camp paperwork process. The structure of the program is also being put together. Part of that is finding adults that can help, so they can complete the CBI and Fingerprints. Youth could be of help but would need to be 16 or older and need supervision. A fee schedule will need to be set up as well for children to attend. Also, we would need to pay the staff doing the camp as well. The monies that are associated with this camp will be in its own account. The board needed to take direction at this meeting to determine if this is what we want for WCC and to continue moving forward. This will be done in the New Business section.

Florence Barnett presented for the Membership Committee, visitor for the month. The Membership Committee served for Confirmation Dinner and served around 80 people, honoring the Confirmands. Bulletins are also being sent out to the elderly or shut-ins. A membership class is going to take place again in September once the summer ends.

Pastor Darrel shared a devotional related to a man who was striving to make God the center of his life. Are we inviting God into our lives daily? Do we pause and pray, do we open up our hearts to let God's light shine in and through us? Darrel referenced parts of the 139th Psalm. God is an ever-present reality in our life.
