



WCC Board News

July 6, 2021

Pastor Darrel opened with Devotional and challenge concerning vision for the church. A call to the Lord for vision concerning the ministries God would have WCC engaged in for the fall and into 2022. Prayers for the church and individuals was lifted up by all. Children's Education Director's report saw an average of 46 kids at VBS with a high of 60. 18 adults and 15 teens provided the staff and VBS was a huge success. Sunday School numbers are down due to summer. Kingdom Kidz planning is occurring for September. Building Committee made a recommendation to put in a retaining wall along the north side of the parsonage backyard fence. Unanimously voted to move ahead. Ray Meyer provided youth report including report on their recent mission trip to Loveland. 12 Teens and 4 adults participated and all were deeply touched by the Lord as they served non-profits and worshipped together. Treasurer Report showed a current general checking balance of \$28,348 as of 7.6.21. Financial Secretary shared that giving continued to be strong with giving for June at \$14,851. Pastor's report was shared, showing Pastor involved in studies, meetings, counseling as well as normal week to week activities. A donation of \$500 to local missionary Ken Fulton with the Navigators was approved. Further discussion occurred concerning supporting ongoing mission work as well as placing a percentage of giving into a building fund. Meeting was dismissed in prayer. Humbly submitted, Marlin Schroeder, Board Clerk
