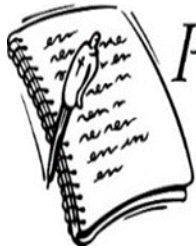

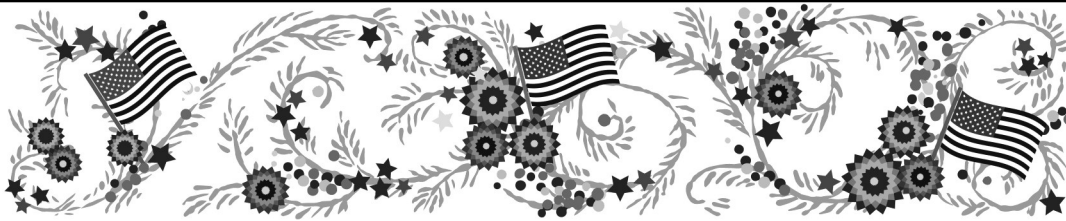

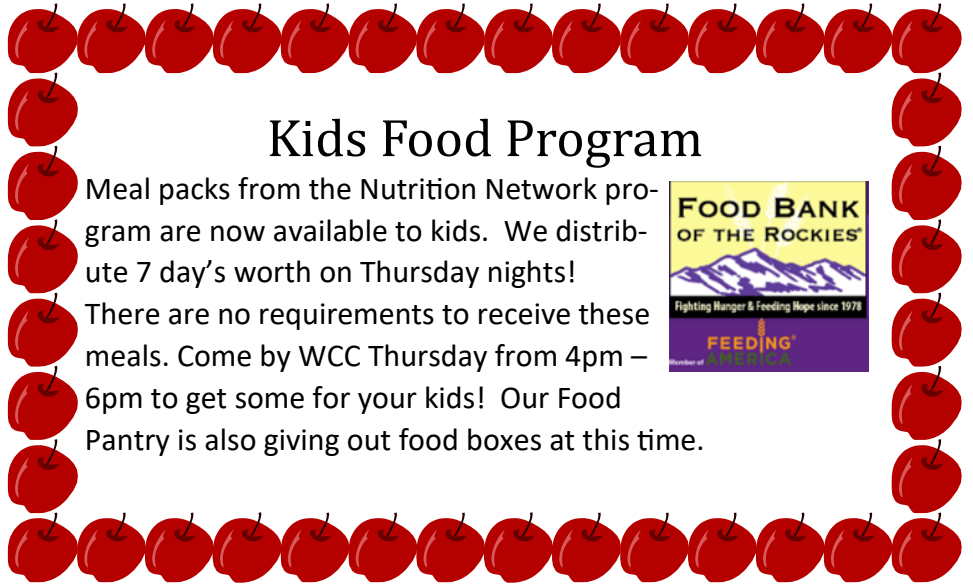

WCC Board News

There was a special presentation to the board at the June 2nd meeting from Kyle Bernhardt. The topic of the presentation was regarding upgrades to our technology at WCC. Ultimately, the search is on for a new camera and computer system to improve our virtual and in person capabilities.

Research completed includes a documented need of either a two or three camera system, with a main and 1-2 auxiliary cameras. Feed would come from the camera, but the audio would still run through the soundboard. This transition will allow for better viewing when music/worship occurs and when the sermon occurs.

A new computer will help the technological upgrades as well. The hardware on the computer will also improve WCC's ability to show virtual services, be better in the streaming category, and also improve what in person congregants will be able to see on the screens and hear. Ultimately, a motion was made, seconded and unanimously carried by the board to spend \$6500 on the upgrade of our audio/visual equipment at WCC. We are excited about the upcoming changes to the system and the improved ability to share what WCC has to offer, both within and outside of Wiggins!
