



Meeting opened with devotional from Pastor Darrel, "Strength only comes from the Lord." Based on Psalm 21, abiding with Christ brings His majesty, splendor and glory into and through our lives. As this occurs, more trust is built in Him and even more of the above occurs.

Jaime Rivera provided Children's Education report. Sunday School for all ages is occurring although attendance in the summer months is low and was expected. VBS is ready to kick-off with lots of volunteers!

Jeremy Reed reported for the youth. After a bonfire and hangout time, summer break is occurring with the youth program. 14 teens and 4 adults are scheduled for youth camp June 27th-July 2nd.

Jeremy Reed, Financial Secretary, shared report as well as Treasurer Report for Sharon Ruyle who was not able to attend. Giving continues to be strong with May at \$16,524. Monthly attendance is now averaging 87 with on-line viewing at 154 average per week. Pastor Darrel gave his report on various activities, meeting with men and Bible studies occurring throughout the week.

A bid was received by Kinnon Audio and Visual to upgrade some of the sound equipment, wiring, microphones and do some training. A motion was made and all were in favor for these upgrades.
