Pastor's Notes

Some of you saw the post I put on Facebook a week or two ago. Here it is again. It is from a book from Fredrick Farrar, The Life of Christ. He wrote the following... "It is easy to be a slave to the letter of the law and difficult to enter into the Spirit; easy to obey a number of outward rules, difficult to enter intelligently and self-sacrificially into the will of God; easy to entangle the soul in a network of petty observances, difficult to yield to be humbly spiritual; easy to be a formalist, difficult to be pure, loving, wise and free; easy to be a Pharisee, difficult to be a disciple; easy to embrace a self-satisfying and sanctimonious system of religious observances, very difficult to love God with all the heart, might, soul and strength." end quote...

It is only by abiding in the presence of Jesus that a spiritual relationship can be maintained amid our physical world. The presence of Christ is the only power strong enough to hold us tight, to protect us from the worries, the pleasures and the riches of this life which can so easily sway us away. 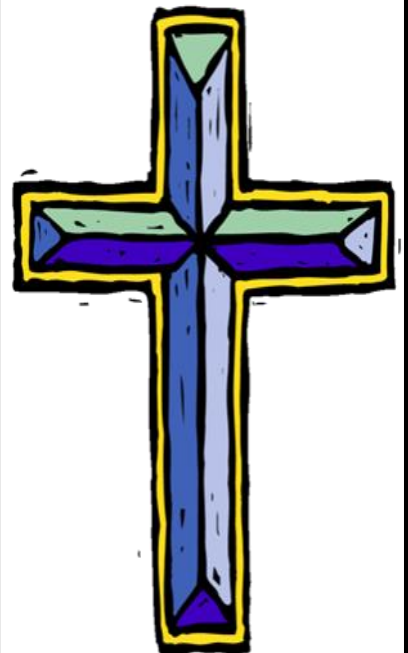

Youth report was orally shared by Pastor Darrel. He was encouraged with Ray Meyer's leadership, as well as Patricia Goddard and others, in the school and for Baccaulerette. Personalized Bibles were handed out to the seniors who faithfully attended Fellowship of Christian Students.

Financial report from Dana Mildenberger was shared. Church average was 111 for April. Giving was \$15,901. Treasurer's report given by Sharon Ruyle. Pastor's Report stated ongoing pastoral duties.

Old business included the following: the possibility of a Christian School in the future. The possibility of creating a financial paid position, combining the treasurer and financial secretary positions, update on parking lot resurface. Scheduled in the first week of June.

New business included Youth camp, the church will cover expenses not raised for the 11 teens attending. Bibles for Prison Ministry and new Bible study at Rising Up in Fort Morgan was discussed.

Board members were asked to fill out a questionnaire about all the ministries of the church and to prayerfully seek vision for future ministries and building/grounds upgrades.


