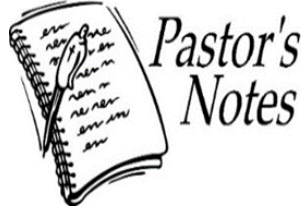

Psalm 23 *The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want. ² He makes me to lie down in green pastures; He leads me beside the still waters. ³ He restores my soul; He leads me in the paths of righteousness for His name's sake. ⁴ Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; For You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me. ⁵ You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; You anoint my head with oil; My cup runs over. ⁶ Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life; And I will dwell in the house of the LORD Forever.*



This very familiar Psalm of David is one we need to hear in these days. In the midst of the COVID-19 pandemic, the fires we are experiencing here in Colorado and the election, the days are very trying. We can easily lose sight of who is really in control.

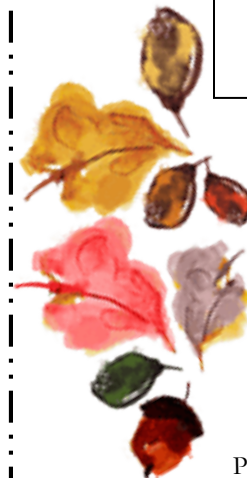

WCC Board News October 6, 2020

Devotional: Pastor Darrel provided a devotional for the board, out of Psalms 5. The impact of the world on us recently has been hard... Psalms 5 provides us some insight to how David handled the worldly chaos around him. Prayer then was shared around the table.

Youth/Sunday School Report: The report was provided by Jeremy Reed to discuss the Youth Group. Epic Youth had \$700 of inflows and the outflows mainly came from the daily devotionals Ray is doing at the school. The balance at the end of the month of September was \$1063.43. A movie night is in store for this month as the youth have had some intense study in Romans recently.

Sunday School had an inflow of \$540 vs \$474.23 of outflows in September for a new balance of \$996.86. David made a motion to approve the Youth/Sunday School Report, seconded by Jeremy, and the motion carried.

Financial Secretary's Report: Provided by Sharon Ruyle. Attendance for September averaged 87, the highest average since February of this year. Week four of September had 94 individuals in attendance. Total inflows for the month were \$10,063.02, bills for September were \$12,711.96.

Budget committee will be meeting soon to discuss the 2021 budget, forecasting our expenses for the next year. An initial meeting will occur in October.

The Pastoral Relations Committee will also be forming soon to prep for Pastor Darrel's evaluation.

Discussion on new board members occurred. The goal of discussion was to bring forth prayer and thought for potential new board members as there will be three outgoing members at the end of 2020.
