## Pastor's Notes

I have shared these thoughts several times over the last couple of weeks. It has really ministered to me and will continue to minister to me over the next several weeks. It is taken from Joshua 1.

When Moses was used by God to lead the Israelites out of their Egyptian captivity he had two key men at his side. One was his brother Aaron and the other was Joshua. As the Israelites were journeying

to the Promised Land they were attacked by Amalek's army and it was Joshua that God used to launch a counterattack, assuring victory for God's people.

It was Joshua along with Caleb, who came back with a "since God is with us we can do this" attitude from the surveillance mission into Promised Land. And it was Joshua that God selected to lead His chosen people into the Promised Land. Out of the million+ people who left Egypt, Joshua and Caleb would be the only two individuals God allowed to enter into the Promised Land and the two who would lead the descendants of the Israelites into the Promised Land.

As the Israelites were preparing to cross the Jordon River into the Promised Land God spoke to Joshua and encouraged him that He was with Him and would give him "every place on which the sole of his foot treads." Then God encouraged Joshua to "be strong and courageous." Three times God said this to Joshua. In 9<sup>th</sup> verse of Joshua 1 God said, "Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous! Do not tremble or be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go"

Oh, how many times we need to hear this from our Lord. Oh, how many times we need to read this from His Word! "Be strong and courageous for I am with you." How many times do we need to hear this as we walk through the troubles and trials of this life?

I also found it amazing that in Joshua 1, as Joshua was relating to the Israelite people what God had told him. they replied with the following. Joshua 1:16-18, "And they answered Joshua, saying, "All that you have commanded us we will do, and wherever you send us we will go. Just as we obeyed Moses in all things, so we will obey you; only may the Lord your God be with you, as He was with Moses...only be strong and courageous."

Joshua was encouraged by God with the be strong and courageous and then he encouraged the people who in turn encouraged Joshua back with the same words, be strong and courageous. Pretty amazing isn't it? I think this is the cycle God wants each of us in. Encouragement flowing all around. Oh, how we need to hear not just these words from God but from each other. "Be strong and courageous." Take heart!

Church, I have been ministered to by the Lord by these words so please hear my prayer for you this day. "May the Lord your God be with you and may you be strong and courageous as you follow Him in all your ways." Now...who can you encourage with these words?

### WCC Board News

The WCC Board met for it's monthly meeting on August 4th. Absent from the meeting was Charlie Ruyle, Donna Oleari and Rick Wymore. The meeting started with a special presentation from Building and Grounds in regards to our parking lot. After thorough discussion, there is no forward plan at this time and a motion was made to table this specific project.

A devotional was led by Pastor Darrel with the theme being leaning on each other, and finding ways to unite together as a board and as a Church. The Apostles found strength in times of need by being together. That is a calling for WCC as well, to come together and be filled by the Holy Spirit.

The Financial Secretary's report showed an average attendance for July at 41. Online giving has been substantial and is something noteworthy of praise. For July, online giving was at \$3444.24. That helped our total inflow for July total out to be \$16054.24 against \$12306.73 in expenses. That puts WCC in July 2020 at a net income of \$3847.51.

New Business highlights included the motion to start looking for a stove for the parsonage as the current stove is almost unusable. A motion was also made to hire Sergio Rivera as the new custodian pending an official signed resignation from Josh Shipman. The board also approved purchasing gift cards to Walmart for Teacher's Appreciation Sunday and also motioned to donate \$250 to Rosalita Chamberlin to assist with funeral costs.

The next board meeting is scheduled for September 1st, 2020 at 6:30 PM.
