

Pastor's And came home safely. The team of 22 individuals worked seamlessly and efficiently, ministering to over 470 men, women and children. We were tired but refreshed by doing the Lord's work. We handed out 100 Bibles to families, thousands of vitamins, and other needed medicines. We prayed with many, attended Sunday services where I preached, visited two different Mayan ruins, and enjoyed the company of our host, Pastor Dave

& Dupe Abegami.

Pastor Dave & his wife relocated to Belize from Nigeria 17 years ago. Before leaving Nigeria, they were attending classes with YWAM (Youth with a Mission), the same as our Timmy Paxton is doing in Panama. It is amazing the connections we are seeing around the world. Pastor Dave & his wife concentrated on pastoral ministry and education. Through God's leading they were able to start a high school, the only high school in a very large area. The government of Belize only provides through an 8th grade education. 50 students attend the high school and learn higher education as well a biblical education. It is truly amazing what God has done through Dave & Dupe's time there.

As I spent time with Dave & Dupe, I was reminded of the commitment it takes for someone who is called to go to a foreign country. Family and friends and familiar settings are all left behind. Strange customs, a strange language and, in the case of Dave & Dupe, voodoo, witch doctors, spells and all kinds of evil abound. The people in Belize have a mixture of voodoo and Catholicism. They are still bound by the things they were brought up in, not being completely set free by Jesus. That is the ministry of Dave & Dupe. Just as Jesus was sent to set captives free, missionaries, pastors and all disciples of Jesus are sent to set the captives free. Set them free from what? From the grip of Satan, from the grip of sin, from the grip of anxiety, from the grip of society, from the grip of so many things.

Jesus said in John 8:31-32, "If you hold to My teachings, you are really My disciples. Then you will know the truth and the truth will set you free." Round table prayer opened meeting. Children's Report by Carly Erker was shared. Financial Secretary reported monthly average of 87. End of Year shows a total giving of \$235,576. Treasurer's Report was shared, normal bills to be paid approved. Dana has taken over Treasurer duties as Sharon is out for medical leave. (Sean Bowling asked to sub as a voting member till official ballots are voted upon). Board voted to specify which accounts Dana and Glen are allowed access to in order to assure that bils are paid and checks are signed. Discussion continued in regard to a By-Law change. By-Laws committee presented their changes to the Boar ahead of the Congregational vote to he held on the 16th of February. Pastor shared his report. Open position for Children's Ministry Leader was discussed. Post was shared via website, facebook, and church announcements. Three applicants were considered. Motion to hire Jody Shipman was accepted, Carly Erker to spend rest of the month training Jody. Need to expand the scope of Youth Ministry was discussed. The board discussed new board members for the coming election. If By-Law changes get accepted, will also need to consider replacing Dana with an eligible voting member. Pastor considering a second retreat in 2025 to Kenya if approved. Motion to gift Frontier School of the Bible Choir & Drama Team \$500 for their visit and performance was accepted. Meeting closed in prayer by Glen Gray.
