As you have heard, a team made up of myself, Chris & Priscilla Franzen, Rob Mayer and Timmy Paxton, are heading to Kisii, Kenya September 22<sup>nd</sup>-October 3<sup>rd</sup>. We are also praying about a trip to Honduras in February/March. (We are hoping to keep the Honduras trip cost down, approx. \$1,500, so check your calendar!). So there is a lot going on. Sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ across the world.

Why missions? Why go to a foreign country to share the Gospel when there is so much work to do here in the states and even around Wiggins? Several reasons. First, it is a commission from Jesus Himself to His church. After Jesus was resurrected and right before He ascended back to heaven, He gave these instructions to His followers. Acts 1:8, "...but you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth.

Our Jerusalem is Wiggins and the surrounding area. Judea is when we reach out into the county and beyond. We have a lot of things going on here and in the county. Our Mission's Committee, Food Bank and Prison Ministry is ministering to many, many people. Samaria and the remotest part of the earth is when we reach out to the people of Belize, Peru, Kenya and possibly Honduras.

As I am writing this, I am reminded of how anxious the believers in Macedonia were to share

gifts and offerings with the poor in Jerusalem. They knew about the extreme poverty occurring there and they were anxious to help. We know about the poverty in third world countries like Kenya, Peru,

Belize and Honduras. We know how a little relief can make a huge emotional and spiritual impact.
In Kenya, as I have developed relationships with eight pastors, the one thing they asked for was Bibles as they were out of reach financially for most. One of our members has sent them money to purchase over 100 Bibles and in total, over 160 Bibles have been purchased for the churches to hand to their members. I was studying the life in Kenya and saw the average teacher makes \$467 a month. Can you imagine trying to raise your family on so little? The need is great in so many ways that when the call to go came, after prayerfully discerning the voice of the Lord, we said, "Here am I, send me."

While in Kenya we will be teaching, preaching, encouraging, worshipping and installing a water purification system at an orphanage. We were blessed to have a company sponsor this unit at \$2,000. Water born diseases is something they constantly deal with. We hope to purchase small water filtration systems for the pastor's homes as well at \$50 each. Maybe this is something you would like to help

You can see in this newsletter that we are having a fund-raising lunch to help off-set travel expenses for our team. Pray about this and pray about the travel, safety, the teachings and the interaction with the churches and their pastors. May the team be Spirit led in all we do. Thank you church. We are blessed to be representing you as we go to the ends of the earth to share the love of Jesus Christ.
