



How To Keep Flowers Fresh

Clean Vase

Use a clean vase to prevent the growth of bacteria, which can shorten the lifespan of your flowers.

Trim Stems

Cut about 1-2 inches off the stems at an angle using sharp scissors or pruning shears. This allows for better water absorption.

Flower Food

Use the flower food that often comes with the bouquet. Follow the instructions on the packet for the correct amount to add to the water.

Cool Location

Place the flowers in a cool room. Avoid putting them near heaters, radiators, or other heat sources.

Avoid Fruit

Keep the flowers away from fruits, as they release ethylene gas, which can age the flowers prematurely.

If you notice the water becoming cloudy or the flowers drooping, recut the stems and change the water. Fresh Water

Fresh Water: Fill the vase with fresh, lukewarm water. Change the water every 2-3 days to keep it clean and clear.

Remove Leaves

Remove any leaves that will be submerged in water, as they can promote bacterial growth.

Avoid Sunlight

Keep the flowers away from direct sunlight, as it can cause them to wilt faster.

Avoid Drafts

Keep the flowers away from drafts, as they can accelerate the drying process.

Mist the Petals

Lightly mist the petals with water using a spray bottle. This helps to keep the flowers hydrated.

Preservation Techniques

Consider drying or pressing the flowers if you want to preserve them for longer periods.
