(Gal. 5:22-23)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">12</p> <p>Read: Acts 15:36-16:15 Pray: that effort would cause the church to be not just another building-but for the Lord! Lord, we praise you for your consistency during these turbulent times in our culture and church. During these 40 days give us the courage to seek your vision for the future of our congregation.”</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">18</p> <p>Read: Acts 19 Pray: “Holy God, your mission is to redeem the world. Open our eyes to see you moving in our community. Open our ears to hear your call. Open our hearts to love our neighbors. Open our minds to imagine new ways to share the good news of Jesus.”</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">19</p> <p>Read: Acts 20 Pray: Declare that the ministries of the church would “not be ashamed of this Good News about Christ. It is the power of God at work, saving everyone who believes.” (Rom. 1:16)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">20</p> <p>Read: Acts 21 Pray: that the work of FAUMC Church will “equip God’s people to do God’s work and build up the church, until we come to unity in our faith and knowledge of God’s Son that we will be mature in the Lord, ...becoming more and in every way like Christ.” (Eph. 4:12-13, 15)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">21</p> <p>Read: Acts 22 Pray: that FAUMC worship would cause “deaf people to hear words read from a book, and blind people see through the gloom and darkness. The humble will be filled with fresh joy from the Lord. The poor will rejoice in the Holy One of Israel.” (Isaiah 29:18)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">22</p> <p>Read: Acts 23 Pray: that God will give FAUMC Church a complete understanding of what God wants to do in each person’s life, and that God will make each person wise with spiritual understanding.
