Pastor Greg is making plans to lead a youth Confirmation Class beginning this fall. The

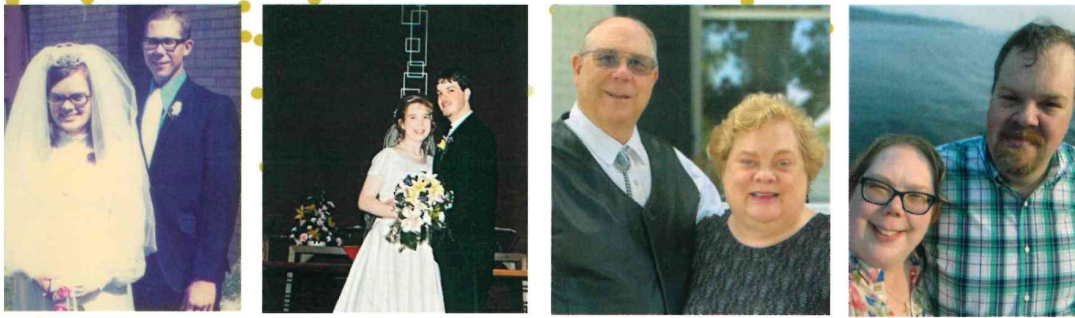
