- Haleigh Bryant, LSU gymnast, National Champion, 2024 USA Olympic National Team
- Veronica Campbell Brown, Jamaican sprinter, and three-time gold medalist at the Olympic Games
- Stephen Curry, Golden State Warriors, four-time NBA champion and two-time MVP, FIBA World Cup (winning two gold medals). He will play in his first Olympics when he steps on the court at Paris 2024 representing the USA Men's National Basketball Team.



- Caeleb Remel Dressel, American professional swimmer who is a seven-time Olympic gold medalist and holds world records in the 100 meter butterfly (long course and short course), He has won gold medals at the 2017 World Aquatics Championships (seven gold medals), 2018 World Swimming Championships (nine medals, six of which were gold)in Hangzhou, , at the 2019 World Aquatics Championships (eight medals, including six gold). At the 2020 Summer Olympics in Tokyo, Dressel won five gold medals, which made him the fifth American to win five gold medals in a single Olympic Games.
- Cori Dionne "Coco" Gauff, American professional tennis player. She has won seven WTA Tour singles titles, including a major at the 2023 US Open, and eight doubles titles. She will play in her first Olympics when she steps on the court at Paris 2024 representing the USA Women's Tennis Team.
- Michael D. Johnson, retired American sprinter who won four Olympic gold medals and eight World Championships gold medals in the span of his career.
- Diana Taurasi, American professional basketball player (WNBA, Phoenix Mercury, five-time gold Olympic champion for the USA Women's National Basketball Team.
- Maria Yuryevna Kirilenko, former Russian professional tennis player. She was a semifinalist at the 2012 London Olympics (where she lost to Victoria Azarenka in the bronze medal match.
- **Isabell Werth** retired German equestrian, who has left an indelible mark with an impressive tally of 10 Olympic medals, including 6 golds.
