

## WEEK 1 (6/29-7/2) "Mixed Media Tape"

\*Closed 7/3 in observance of Independence Day

Students will blend everyday household and classroom materials, exploring various artistic mediums to transform familiar objects into something entirely new! Activities include practicing upcycling with recycled materials, a visit from local mixed-media artist **Ani Mesropian**, and the return of **Beatbox Panda**, who will lead a beatboxing workshop with guitar accompaniment by **Millie Melodies**. The children will also have access to various drums and instruments.

## WEEK 2 (7/6-7/10): "Filming Frenzy"

There are so many different ways to tell a story. This week, children will explore with filmmaker **Brett Caughie** to capture their visions through visual storytelling. Our Junior Dragons will spend the week crafting a short story, making puppets and backdrops, and performing their own puppet play. Meanwhile, the older Dragons will dive into the world of documentary-making, collaborating as characters, interviewers, and set designers.

## WEEK 3 (7/13-7/17): "Awesome Athletes"

Physical activity supports mental well-being, and this week children will discover fun ways to get moving. Enrichment opportunities include **Coach Marshall** (Basketball Coach and front man of the Marshall Law Band) who will guide children through engaging, team-focused games. **B-Boy Fidget** and his **Fraggle Rock Crew** will also host a workshop on the fundamentals of breakdancing.

## WEEK 4 (7/20-7/24): "Curious Cuisine"

Studies show that involving children in the kitchen early fosters life skills, independence, and healthy eating habits. Dragon's Den will invite campers to discover the joy of cooking through hands-on experiences. Activities include, a cooking session hosted by a **local cooking guru**, creating lemonade with fresh lemons, tortilla making, and more! **Coach Marshall** returns this week, and campers will enjoy a special drum circle led by local musician and instructor, **Arturo Rodriguez**, joined by a fellow instrumentalist.

## WEEK 5 (7/27-7/31): "Splish, Splash!"

This is often the hottest week of the summer, but we know just how to keep it fun! Children will stay cool with a variety of water themed activities! Water-balloon throwing and popsicle-making will be followed by whimsical story-time selections from our local library. We'll wrap up this week's camp session with a special visit from the **All-City Ice Cream Truck!** **Coach Marshall** also returns this week!

## WEEK 6 (8/3-8/7): "Exceptional Engineers"

This week, it's all about tinkering, asking questions, and seeking solutions! Campers will welcome students from the **Cleveland High School STEMster Program** for hands-on STEM activities led by high school mentors, offering fun, interactive opportunities to explore science, technology, engineering, and math. We also welcome **Arturo Rodriguez** back, leading a lively drum circle with a fellow instrumentalist!

## WEEK 7 (8/10-8/14): "Amazing Animals"

Our vast Earth is home to countless creatures, and this week students will explore and learn more about them. Activities include acrylic animal painting, a planned trip to the Seattle Aquarium (*awaiting confirmation, parents notified by 3/31*), and a visit from **Animal Encounters**, where children will learn about mammals and interact with rabbits, guinea pigs, chinchillas, a Bennett's Wallaby, and an African pygmy hedgehog!

## WEEK 8 (8/17-8/21): "Illustrious Illustrators"

Campers will explore various methods of visual storytelling, working with comic books and graphic novels, and even creating their own comic book! Enrichment activities will feature a special story-time visit from beloved characters who step right off the pages of our favorite books! Summer camp will conclude with a visit from local magician **AlakaSam**, who will also entertain with balloon twisting!
